From the Editor...



All of the seasonal clubs are now up and running so you shouldn't have any problems finding a place to dance. Enjoy it while you can; in March, the seasonal clubs will start shutting down again.

There will be a special celebration in Lakeland on Tuesday, January 28th at the Magnolia Building, 702 Orange Street. The oldest square and round dance club in the state of Florida will be celebrating their 62nd anniversary. Art Springer, who has called for B&B for about 40 years, will be calling, and Charlie Lovelace, who has been cueing for the club for about 30 years, will be cueing. All the past presidents we can locate are being invited to attend. We hope you can join us for this momentous occasion.

This weekend is the big Florida Winter Festival at the Lakeland Center in Lakeland starting with a Trail-in Dance on Thursday, January 30th, and ending on Saturday, February 1st. This is a dance hosted by Grande Square International. Callers for the weekend are Tony Oxendine, Jerry Story, John Saunders, Jack Pladdys, and Tim Crawford. Cuers are Rey and Sherry Garza and Jimmy and Carol Griffin. And yes, Tony will be here! If dancing the whole weekend is too much for you, you can come for one day if you like, but you have to purchase those ribbons at the window. I still have some ribbons left if you haven't purchased yours yet. Please note that there is no Mainstream dancing at this weekend. The levels are Plus, Plus DBD, and Advance. Did you know that the in-state club and out-of-state club with the most pre-registrations by January 30th will be awarded \$200? Each registrant must indicate their club when registering. All white badge Florida Callers Association members and members of the Round Dance Council of Florida as listed in the latest issue of the *Bow & Swing*, are admitted free. They must check in at the registration window to pick up your ribbon.

Our next West Coast Association dance will be on Sunday, February 9th, in the Ballroom of the Lake Ashton Clubhouse in Lake Wales. Early Rounds are from 1:30 – 2:00 p.m., and alternating Mainstream and Plus squares are from 2:00 – 4:00 p.m. Keith Stevens will be the MC and any callers or cuers who are interested in being on the program for the afternoon, are asked to notify Keith of your interest. Association members are free and guests are \$5 per person.

Immediately preceding the dance there will be a West Coast Association meeting starting at 12:00 noon in the Ballroom. Please plan to come early and attend this meeting so you can learn about the Association and what we do.

Mark your calendars! February 12th is our annual Dancing at the Fair event. For 20+ years, we have danced at the Florida State Fair and we'll be there again this year. The dancing will be from 11:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. in the Special Events Building. There will be a Grand March at 1:00

p.m. Please wear square dance attire and don't forget your club banners! Sharon Short is the lead caller and Pat Hagen is the lead cuer. If you would like to call and/or cue for this event, please contact Sharon or Pat. It is unknown at this time if there will be free tickets available. If we are able to obtain some, they will be disbursed to the West Coast Association clubs. Even if you don't receive a free ticket, the admission to the fair is very minimal. In addition to the dance, you will be able to enjoy the activities of the fair.

In March the Shamrock Swing will be held at the Villages with Tony Oxendine and Chris Phillips calling and Joanne Helton cueing. This is always a good dance, and again, if you only want to come for a part of it you can purchase those ribbons at the window. I have ribbons for sale if you would like to purchase your ribbons in advance.

Callerlab Viewpoints - Spread the Word about “Winning Ways”

For many years now, CALLERLAB has collected and shared the stories of clubs and associations having success in their new dancer programs and other activities. Yes, there have always been groups that have had better than average to phenomenal success with their classes and events because they found a way to do things right. This is especially true right now.

CALLERLAB realized long ago that every time we turned around we were hearing stories of big new dancer programs, fun club outings, terrific charity events, and clubs that were growing. We decided to start collecting these stories, so that other motivated groups could learn new ways to grow and enjoy the same success. “Winning Ways” is the collection of these stories and is still a work in progress with new submissions every year.

I personally believe that we would have quadrupled this collection had we been able to gather every success story out there. We also realize that not everyone knows about the “Winning Ways” project, and our activity has long been handicapped in effective ways of spreading information. Besides getting the word out about the tool for sharing successful ideas, it takes a big effort to write down the information, and there aren’t many in our activity or I society in general that can effectively write and tell their story in word form. Sometimes it takes such a big effort to be successful, that no one has the time to write it down so the success goes unreported and therefore unduplicated.

I’ve read through these submissions and know that it not only takes a new idea, it takes motivated, unselfish, passionate leaders to carry it out.

We have not had many new ideas submitted recently, because there has not been much publicity or promotion of the “Winning Ways” project in recent years. Almost all of the past submissions are as relevant today as they were when they were written, and this article is a start at spreading the word again and adding more ideas to this great project.

All too often, in our clubs, associations, churches, recreation groups, and service organizations, we see leaders and members in conflict over petty things. We have all seen groups that have disbanded, members that have left, and individuals that no longer speak to each other because of some disagreement that, in the big scheme of things, is relatively unimportant or just ego related.

On the other hand, we see groups that have been and continue to be successful because of a spirit of cooperation, a commitment to do what’s best for the group, and an attitude that promotes fun and friendship. The desire to include everyone in the group is also a huge element. Having a club that is dedicated to making everyone feel welcome and appreciated is a big contributing factor to initial lasting success.

Another part of a successful project, event, or club is having one or more excited and passionate leaders working hard to make things happen. I call them “spark plugs” or “go getters”. Whatever you call them, they are an important part of every successful club and endeavor.

Imagine for a moment a scenario I’ve seen time and time again. Someone in your group has an idea that they’ve either heard about, or thought of all by themselves. They bring up this idea during a club or association meeting and immediately have people say, “Oh that won’t work”, or “We’ve tried that before”.

The naysayers and pessimists shoot the idea down and the club continues to struggle, without so much as an effort or an attempt to do anything. On the other hand, I’ve seen groups roll up their sleeves and work together to start a something they hope will succeed, and keep modifying it as they go, until does. Sometimes the project doesn’t work the first or second time, but then it finally builds momentum and the “sparks fly”.

CALLERLAB applauds and congratulates those callers, dance leaders, and dancers that have gone and continue to go the extra mile. Most of these leaders are fun to be around, have a wonderful positive attitude, and try to include everyone in the club to help and join in the festivities. Many also have this amazing knack to get others to trust and follow them in whatever capacity is needed. They create this feeling of camaraderie and fellowship that is like a magnet to new people and to veteran recruiters alike.

CALLERLAB invites everyone to go to their website at www.callerlab.org and look up, read, download, and share each “Winning Way” with their own group. After going to the website, click on the “Where Can I Find” box in the left hand column, then type in “Winning Ways” in the upper right corner. After clicking the arrow just to the right of that box, you will see all the information that has been submitted and even how to submit your own “Winning Ways” ideas.

Not all these ideas are right for everyone or every group, but sometimes just one part of an idea can really make the difference in something you are already doing or contemplating. Read these ideas with an open mind, and even if one idea is really not the right thing for your club, read them all and I guarantee that you will find something that can work for you and improve your club.

3 Secrets Every New Square Dancer Should Know (& You Should too)

Ever had those days when it seems others are staring at you as you make another mistake and are barely getting by? What is it that they know that you have not yet discovered?

This free report is intended to help you discover 3 Secrets Every Square Dancer Should Know:

1. You should seek to grasp a mindset of welcoming the fun of dancing into your life and using it to benefit those around you. You and everyone you dance with will make mistakes at one time or another. Laugh about it. Have fun. Intend to do better next time, but remember, mistakes means you are human and still have some things to learn, that's all.

2. The better dancers are really better at knowing what formation they are in, where they are in the square, and where others should be. Their secrets include: take hands whenever you can to establish their formation (line, wave, square, etc.); always align your formations with the walls to help you better see $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, etc.; and always try to remember movements starting and ending positions – for instance, trade is always $\frac{1}{2}$ way, that is, the wall you start facing will be behind you when complete.
3. The better dancers always take Action. They strive to dance to a variety of callers, with dancers from a variety of clubs and geographic locations, and they seek out workshops and other learning opportunities. Nearly all will attend conventions, festivals, and other fun events to further gain quality practice floor time while enjoying new friends.
4. BONUS: Always dance for fun, enjoy the people, remember life is short so cooperate rather than develop a “my club is better than yours” or “I’m a better dancer than you” attitude. Enjoy People and Enjoy the Dance!
5. In summary, the 3 Secrets of the Better Dancers are not really secrets at all. Instead, they are Clarity in their thinking, willingness to take hands and dance for fun with everyone, and make a decision to Take Action by traveling to larger events. Many times the Action Step is where people hesitate and then end up doing nothing. Don’t let this be you.

The Ability Of European Dancers – Part 2

Last month’s column discussed how Sweden was the first country in Europe to concentrate on learning Mainstream and Plus calls from all positions. It was noted that Sweden did this by accident, since they did not know how square dancing was done elsewhere, they assumed that a person had to understand the calls from a variety of positions. When I did a calling tour to Sweden in 1985, I was amazed at how well everyone danced – far better than in the U.S.

I went back to Sweden in 1986 and 1987, and each time I found more clubs and more callers – all doing Dance By Definition (DBD).

The 1980s saw a spurt of square dancing growth in Germany, Belgium, the Netherlands and England, with the resulting start-up of numerous festivals and weekends – especially in Germany. The Swedish dancers hear about these weekends and began to travel to Germany to dance. Because the Swedes had learned DBD, they were better than many of the dancers at these festivals.

German pride would have none of this, so they quickly began learning DBD too. This spread to Belgium and The Netherlands. Since English dancers often went to German weekends, England went to DBD too.

By the start of the 1990s the transition was complete, and Europe was learning and dancing DBD. In the 1990s there was a square dance boom in Denmark, and since it was adjacent to and influenced by Germany, DBED became the norm there too. In the past decade there has been a strong upsurge of dancing in the Czech Republic, and it too is now dancing a strong DBD.

It should be noted that DBD in Europe only applies to countries where there is a lot of square dancing. Other countries with small square dance have not been attracted to DBD. Also, because of the emphasis of DBD, Advanced and Challenge has flourished in countries with large square dance populations, but not elsewhere.

Because self-taught Swedish dancers did not know how Mainstream and Plus was being presented in the U.S., they inadvertently affected the way that the majority of people in Europe dance today, which is at an extremely proficient level.
