

## American Square Dance Editorial

From Bill Boyd

Does your club allow same sexes dancing together? Someone recently posted this question on Facebook with fairly unanimous response. YES. So far I have only visited one club where this was discouraged. The reason given was that the dancers on the floor were confused when calls were delivered, they expected the opposite gender instead of the same sex. As much as I dislike saying this, I believe it is the callers fault that dancers should be confused by these arrangements. How many callers teach Square Thru with either all boys or all girls. How many teach any of the basics with different gender sequences. I know of several callers, who without teaching highly complex DBD, manage to each several of not only Basics, but Mainstream and

Plus from more than one position. I have found that if most dancers know the Basics well, both mainstream and Plus will be easier to learn. On the subject of teaching, how many try and start classes in January after all of the Holiday breaks? One friend of mine said that this is a good idea because there are fewer dancers who are absent on vacations and at parties. I always thought starting in September was a good idea so you could invite your student dancers to all of your special square dance events surrounding the holidays. This also works if you use one of the ABC or continuous entry programs.

Dear ASD,

I think this is a great idea for promoting our wonderful activity, and I wish every state could do something like I'm about to explain, in some way, shape or form.

Every January, our Pennsylvania Farm Show has an evening of Square Dane competitions and demonstrations. There are usually about 60 squares, ranging from the young to the young at heart. There is a team of callers, where 3 of them are calling and 3 of them are judging. Within the past few years, the team has added a round dance cuer, and most recently a commentator/narrator. The event is 2 hours long and squares are competing for White, Red and Blue Ribbons.

I'm so excited that I've been invited back to be the Monday Night Commentator. What my role is for the duration of the competition is to educate, inform and promote square dancing the best I can. This competition, as well as many other farm show events throughout the week, is televised statewide on The PCN station (Pennsylvania Cable Network), and encore presentations go on all week long at random times of the day. I've done this on a more local level where I was able to get some square dancing and calling and interviews on Public Access and Educational Access TV. Those broadcasts went out throughout our county, but other square dancers saw the TV spot and got a copy of the DVD and went to their area access stations to play them in their neck of the woods. It was great. But this statewide opportunity is quite unique.

## All Things Considered

#### Are You A Dancer Or A Walker?

When you are "dancing", the front half of your foot hits the ground first.

Unfortunately, our activity today should be called "Square Walk", instead of "Square Dance," because that is what people are doing. My guess is that over half of all dancers I see in my travels are "walking" and not" Dancing."

Check yourself at the next square dance. Are you moving, ask yourself: "Is the ball of my foot (front half) hitting the floor first, or is my heel hitting the floor first?" Then watch other people on the floor and ask the same question about them.

When you are "dancing," you are keeping time with the music, you are thinking ahead, you are alert. When you are "walking," you are more relaxed and moving slower, and thus apt to fall behind in the execution of the calls. In addition, being relaxed tends to cause one to think a little slower.

Good dancers "dance," weak dancers "walk." In judging the ability of a floor as a guest caller at the start of a dance, I always check to see how many people are "dancing." The ability level of the floor will be in direct correlation to the number of people dancing."
