## West Coast Association

What's involved being on the West Coast Association Board?

There are currently only two meetings a year; one in the Winter and one before the September President's Ball. It's the president's choice where we these meetings are held. There are approximately six membership dances held in the west coast of Florida area and the annual Fall Fun Fest currently held in Bartow that we would hope you would support. We realize some of the membership dances may be too far for you go. That's not a problem; you don't have to attend every one. There are no required overnight stays.

#### Responsibilities by position:

President: preside over all meetings of the Association; appoint all committees and designate the chairman thereof; submit articles to the *Bow & Swing* and the *West Coast Dancer*.

Vice President: coordinate with area reps the scheduling of the West Coast Membership Dances, scheduling the MC for each of the dances, prepare the flyers, make arrangements for refreshments and/or bring refreshment supplies as needed.

Secretary: record minutes for each membership meeting and distribute copies to designated individuals; sell 50/50 tickets at the membership dances.

Treasurer: collect all dues; order badges and membership bars as needed; keep a record of all receipts and disbursements and make a report at each meeting

County Rep: acts at liaison between the Association and the clubs within their respective counties; coordinate with area reps the scheduling of the West Coast Membership Dances, scheduling the MC for each of the dances; promote West Coast dances. (NOTE: If you already attend all the dances in your county, you would be a good representative. All you would need to do is carry flyers and membership information with you, as well as ribbons for the special dances held in the West Coast Association area.)

This year we need a president(s) and secretary(ies). Why don't you step up and help keep our Association running?

If you have any questions or need clarification on any of these positions, please contact a West Coast Association officer (Slocums, J. Green, Akesons, and Scotts) or I would be happy to discuss it with you.

# West Coast Association Distinguished Service Award

Northeast Florida Square and Round Dancers Association

Ways and Means – Fund Raising Contribution to the Florida Square and Round Dancers 2014 State Convention.

In the January meeting of the Northeast Florida Square and Round Dancers Association (NEFSARDA) a motion was made to donate \$500 to the Florida Square and Round Dancers 2014 State Convention (FSSRDC). Also, asking each club to try to raise an additional \$100 for their portion of supporting the FSSRDC. The expense of putting on a State Convention is over \$30000.
