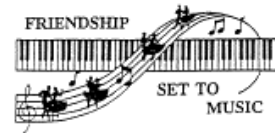

USDA Insurance Coordinator’s Notes

By the time you read this, I will have sent you the rate for 2016. I heard from Markel today and they hope to have it set this week. There are many things that they need to

consider when setting our rate so I can understand why it takes time. We have not had an increase since 2009.

Let me remind you since enrollment time is about to begin that our web site is still the best place to obtain the forms you need to enroll your club each year. If you do not want to use those forms, let me know how many 4-part paper forms you will need for your clubs to enroll for 2016. The web site currently has our 2015 policy available for review if anyone questions you about it. The 2016 policy will be added to [the] site in January when it becomes effective.

The trifolds still have to be printed and will be available soon. The trifold presents our program in a very concise form with both medical and liability sections stating who is covered, what is covered and what is not covered. The required enrollment of 100% of club members is noted on the front of the trifold and should be distributed to all clubs when you send them their insurance certificate after they complete their initial enrollment each year.

Encourage your clubs to begin their enrollment as soon as the fee is known. At times clubs hold back because they are not sure which members are going to pay dues. If this is a concern for the club, just submit the names of the members who have already paid their dues; additional members can be added at a later date when they pay their dues. The fee is the same regardless of when a dancer is submitted for coverage. However, it is important to remind the clubs again and again that 100% of their roster must be covered so that the club does not forget to pay a fee for a club member.

This is important so I am going to repeat information submitted last year! With the end of the year approaching, please note that enrollment fee still needs to be paid for dancers who join clubs during these upcoming months. It is important that a club stay current with their enrollments; it is also important that the chairmen stay current too. As you know the dancer only becomes insured when I receive the correct form and the money for the specific dancer. When submitting your forms during these last few months it will help me if you indicate on your forms if they are for 2015 or 2016 so that I do not have to guess the effective year.

I keep getting questions about student dancers. Students taking beginning classes are covered for nine (9) months at no charge to the club once a student roster is submitted. Students should be encouraged to attend student dances such as half-way, three quarters and graduation dances. They should not be encouraged to attend club dances as their insurance coverage does not cover them for this activity. Their coverage is for activities related to students taking classes.

Always feel free to contact me with questions about coverage or clarification on any issue either through e-mail or via phone.

65th National Square Dance Convention

A New First for the 65th National Square Dance Convention[®] and All Other National Conventions

For the first time ever for a National Convention we have a way for every dancer that is registered to be able to see their information in the computer and update or change their information. This database is not only for the 65th National Square Dance Convention[®] but for all of the national conventions and even some state conventions.

The registration portal web site (which includes updating caller profiles) works equally well on smart phones, tablets and desktop computers. It is designed to be browser-independent, and should work with any browser.

Dancers can register as a new user on the registration portal using industry-accepted practices. (We ask for an email address and confirm that the user has access to that email address before "activating" the user ID)

Users can recover lost passwords by having us send a "reset" message to their email address; clicking on a link in that message allows them to reset their passwords.

If a registration portal user is linked to one of the 7200 known dancers, then that user can see the list of conventions for which they're registered, and can update their convention registrations: changing mailing addresses, email addresses, dance preferences, etc. Basically, it is everything that's on the long [two-sided] registration form.

To access this portal you need to go to the 65th NSDC website which is 65nsdc.org. Then click on the dropdown menu for registration. Then click on the "Convention Registration and Dance Leader login" link. Then follow the instructions for logging in.

We are still working on letting you buy Program Books, Tours and other items through the portal. We will let you know when this is ready to go!

We hope it works smoothly for you.

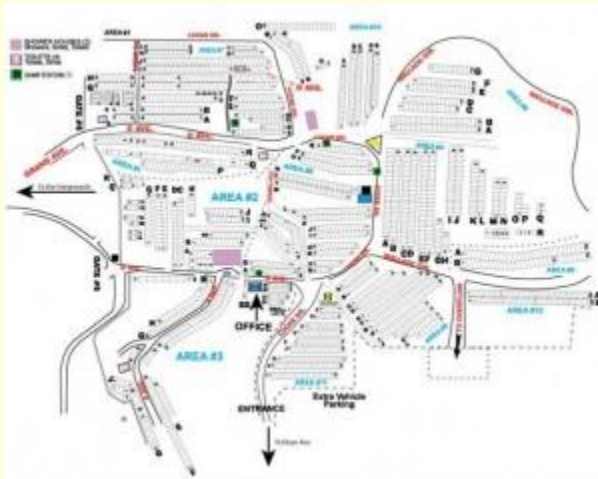
Please return the long form as soon as possible. Details on the form included the purchase of the Program book and dailies, syllabus rounds, tours, Wednesday special event, housing blocks, number of prior convention and type of dancing desired.

We now have a portal where dancers can log into and correct or change their registration information and see what other National Conventions there are registered for. Once you change your information for one convention it is changed for all other Conventions that you are registered for. This is a great step forward into the 21 century. Callers, Cuers and other dance leaders can now do their profiles online also using the same portal. You can find a link to the portal under the registration tab in the menu.

Camping / RVs at the Convention



Camping will be at the Iowa State Fair Campgrounds. This facility has more than 1,800 sites with water and electricity – with more than 600 sites having 50 amp service. All this and only three miles from the convention site! Fees to camp during the convention will be very affordable. Shuttle bus service to the Iowa Events Center will be available for a fee.

You Must Be Registered for the Convention, and send the camping fees with the registration form to the Registration Chairman. Upon payment of your camping fees, you will receive the camping profile, which you should complete and send to the RV Vice-Chairman.

Great meeting today! This is my first time being involved with the National as more than just a dancer attending. I had no idea the number and variety of folks who donated their time to making this happen. Thousands of hours are spent planning, arranging and doing every task from writing an email to contracting for buses to get folks seamlessly from their hotels to the dance and back. It all comes together in a few days in June. I am really looking forward to seeing the fruits of all our labor!

Route 2 to Greater Des Moines STARTING AT FORT MADISON, IA WITH A VARIANCE FROM ROUTE 1 THROUGH SOUTH CENTRAL/CENTRAL IOWA

Head northeast of Fort Madison on the Great River Road (Hwy 61) to Burlington, home of Snake Alley. Then follow Hwy 34 west to Mount Pleasant, home of the Midwest Old Threshers Reunion. Follow Hwy 34 west to Fairfield, Iowa's emergent art scene. You might like to detour south of Fairfield on Hwy 1 to the Villages of Van Buren. Continue from Fairfield west to Ottumwa where the Des Moines River runs directly through the town. Another detour of interest between Fairfield and Ottumwa, via Hwy 16, is Eldon, home of the American Gothic House, made famous by Iowan Grant Wood. On a visit to Blakesburg, off Hwy 34 on T61 between Ottumwa and Albia, you will find the Antique Air Museum, featuring various periods of aviation. It is approximately 20 minutes away from Ottumwa. Continue northwest on Hwy

149/Hwy 23 to Oskaloosa, home of the Nelson Pioneer Farm and Museum, a premier historic attraction. Take Hwy 163 to Pella where you will get the feel of Holland with everything from wooden shoes to Dutch letters. Pella is just 43 miles from Des Moines. Some points of interest along the way:

FORT MADISON, IA: The historic downtown where Victorian architecture abounds, offers an array of specialty shops and five antique stores. The Old Santa Fe Depot Historic Center depicts the community's railroad history. The Santa Fe Bridge was originally built in 1888 and the current bridge was built in 1927. Measuring 525 feet, the bridge is the world's largest double-decker, swing span bridge. The top level accommodates automobile traffic while the lower level provides two tracks for railroad traffic. The bridge rotates to allow river traffic to pass safely. www.visitfortmadison.com

BURLINGTON, IA: Visit Snake Alley, "the crookedest street in the world." Discover the Heritage Hill Historic District, museums, downtown shopping, and beautiful parks. Catch a minor-league baseball game, test your luck at Catfish Bend Casino, and experience the excitement of auto racing at 34 Raceway. www.growburlington.com MOUNT

PLEASANT, IA: Share the charm and history of this rural community and admire the variety of architecture in the homes and businesses. Iowa Wesleyan College is the oldest chartered institution of higher learning west of the Mississippi. Visit the grounds to see the Harlan-Lincoln House, home to James Harlan, U.S. senator and friend to President Abraham Lincoln. Celebrate rural heritage during Midwest Old Threshers Reunion with steam trains and electric trolleys, and working steam engines. www.mountpleasantiowa.org; www.oldthreshers.org

FAIRFIELD, IA: Iowa's foremost art colony, with diverse cultural events, international cuisine and home to Maharishi University of Management, founded by Maharishi Mahesh Yogi. Maharishi Vedic City, Iowa's newest city in 25 years, features unique Vedic architecture and an open-air observatory of masonry sundials that display the movements of the sun, planets, and stars. www.travelfairfieldiowa.com

OTTUMWA, IA: A river town whose name means place of perseverance and land of rippling waters, Ottumwa is the home of Iowa's most famous Indian chiefs, Wapello, Keokuk and Appanoose. Regional attractions include the American Gothic House, Wapello County Museum, and Antique Air Museum. www.visitottumwa.com

OSKALOOSA, IA: There is something for everyone here, from the historic city square with the bandstand to a recreation trail that nearly loops the city. Visit the Nelson Pioneer Farm and Museum, one of the premier historic attractions in Mahaska County. The Nelson home and barn are the focal point of the museum and are designated National Historic Sites by the U.S. Department of Interior. www.oskaloosaiowa.org

PELLA, IA: Pella's architecture gives you the feeling of Holland, along with wooden shoes, delicate Dutch pastries, the musically animated Klokkenspel, Molengracht canal with working drawbridge, and the tallest working windmill in the United States. Pella offers three designated Cultural Districts and beautifully landscaped parks with an array of color. Old World charm and annual tradition peaks in early May at Tulip Time Festival. Pella is also home to Pella Windows and Doors, one of the country's largest manufacturers. The Vermeer Museum and Global Pavilion chronicles the history of Vermeer Corporation and the development of its agricultural products such as the round baler, and

industrial construction equipment including trenchers, boring equipment and environmental equipment. Enjoy a variety of outdoor recreation at nearby Lake Red Rock. www.pella.com.

PRAIRIE CITY, IA: Begin with a visit to the Neal Smith National Wildlife Refuge, and then enjoy four beautiful parks. The Prairie City Historical Society Museum offers a glimpse of the city's past. www.prairiecityiowa.us; www.fws.gov/Midwest/NealSmith

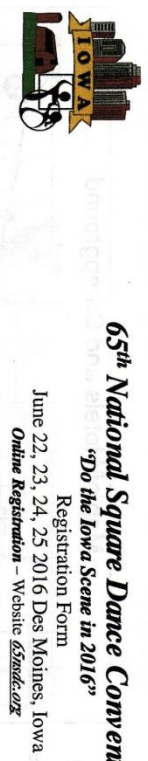

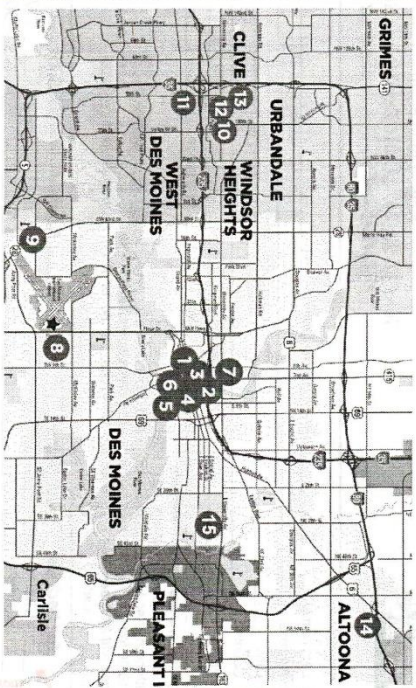

Dancers who choose, may make housing reservations using the printed registration form, the same way dancers have made housing reservations for past Conventions.
