Bow & Swing Editorial

The following is an excerpt from Bill Boyd's editorial in the July 2015 American Square Dance.

"It has happened again in Central Florida. Fortunately not to a square dance club or caller. A local bar is being sued for damages for playing three songs without the proper licenses. According to the newspaper article the fines for playing the songs can range from \$750 to \$30,000 per instance. But, willfully infringing on a copyright can carry a penalty as high as \$150,000. Most people do not know that ASCAP/BMI do not go around checking for illegal music. What usually happens is a person in the know check to see if someone is licensed and if they are not, that person an turn the place in for a share of the fine. Yes, good old fashioned bounty hunting. With fines on the rise and the ability to play unlicensed music easier, we will see more and more of this type o lucrative bounty hunting. Why am I bringing all of this up again? Because there are callers out there without a license. I do not care if a caller is licensed through Callerlab or ACA or any other source. The caller should be licensed. Now for a surprise. If you hire an unlicensed caller for your club, the club is responsible to have a license for all of the called music! Yes, the club is responsible to see if the caller is licensed, and if not, the club must have the correct licenses or they (the club) will be responsible for the fines involved or any music played. I think the odds of any club or caller being monitored are slim. I however am not willing to take the chance, and I would hope that callers and clubs will abide by the law to the best of their abilities."
