

From the Editor...



You can tell the snowbirds are leaving; the list of dances below is getting shorter and shorter every week! There are several clubs that continue to dance through summer. Please support them with your attendance. Now is your time to dance at clubs that you don't get to dance with during the season. The clubs that I know of that dance through the summer are Buttons & Bows

of Lakeland, Citrus Squares (Dunnellon), Promenade Squares (sporadically – watch the DANCERgram for their schedule), Cultural Center Squares (Port Charlotte), Palace Promenaders (Arcadia), Strawberry Square (special summer program (watch DANCERgram for schedule), Suncoast Squares, and Temple Twirlers.

Cliff and I recently prepared a report for a meeting which I wasn't able to present. So rather than it be a total waste of our time, I decided to print it in this week's issue.

"The DANCERgram is a weekly electronic publication that was started in 2005 the first time I was president of the West Coast Association. Today's version evolved

from the Buttons & Bows of Lakeland newsletter which I had started prior to becoming active in the West Coast Association. It grew to be a newsletter for Polk County, and now the target audience is the West Coast Association area of Florida.

Even though the majority of the publication pertains to our activities in this area, there are dancers from all over the state as well as several from out-of-state who have asked to be added to the distribution list. Circulation is currently 700, plus some individuals forward the newsletter on to members of their club so "true" distribution could be close to 1,000. One of the distribution lists contains 11 names of people who only receive the weekly publication. This weekly distribution list contains the names of the editors of the regional newsletters, *Bow & Swing* and *American Square Dance*, and a few callers who make frequent visits to Florida.

It started out as just a weekly publication and then I started receiving requests for a website. I know nothing about building a website so square dancer offered to build one for me. He then gave me instructions on how to upload everything to the site. The DANCERgram website moved to its own server on March 11, 2016 due to the generous contribution of a square dancer who is funding the website hosting. Previously the DANCERgram was an "add-on" to another website at no cost; however there were daily capacity limits that at times rendered the site unavailable; and website traffic statistics weren't available.


About 25% of the visitors read the DANCERgram from the website (irrespective of their also receiving a copy by email?)






Note – the scale for each category is independent of the other categories.

If you have never visited the website (which is <u>www.dancergram.com</u>), it is each section of the publication uploaded as a separate document. There is a menu bar down the left side of the screen identifying each section. You will find an **archive** of DANCERgram publication back to 2007 as well as copies of articles I have written. The **Meetings** document lists the meetings for the West Coast Association, Florida Federation, Florida Callers Association, and Round Dance Council of Florida. The **Classes** document not only includes the square and round dance classes in our area but also all the caller colleges, and clinics (rounds and squares) that I can find. The **Due Dates** document is a list of the deadlines for submissions to all the regional publications, *Bow & Swing, National Square Dance*, award nominations, due date for callers and cuers to sign up for the state convention, etc. All of these sections are important, but one really important section is **Looking Ahead**. You will find individual lists by year of upcoming theme and special dances, conventions, and festivals through 2019. I attempt to

list the state convention for every state in the nation due to the many snowbirds in our area.

In conjunction with the DANCERgram publication, I maintain a master calendar of <u>all</u> the dances in our area as well as regional festivals and clinics. At the beginning of the calendar year, this calendar can be 50 pages long. If you ever want to check for dance conflicts, I probably have the most complete listing and I am willing to check for conflicts. However in order for the calendar to be complete I need to receive the information from the callers, cuers, and clubs.

I re-print numerous articles I think will be of interest to the dancers, callers, and cuers and I also write my own articles which I am proud to say have been reprinted on several occasions in the regional publications, the *Bow & Swing*, and *American Square Dance*. I have subscriptions to each of the regional newsletters, the *Bow & Swing*, *American Square Dance* and *USDA News* where I find the articles I re-print. Each year I request that press releases for the Florida State Convention and the National Square Dance Convention be sent to me when they are sent to other publications so I can include them in the DANCERgram.

On the home page we highlight upcoming special dances and there is a list of all the clubs in the West Coast Association area, special dances, multi-day events, etc. where you can just click on any of the links and you will be taken to the flyer.

It takes me two to three hours to produce an issue, upload it to the website, and then email it to the 700 people on the distribution list.

I also respond to inquiries for dance information for our area as well as around the state."

Why do I give you this information? I don't believe people are aware of the other services that are provided with the DANCERgram. People also don't understand the importance of having this information on the internet. I have been told numerous times by dancers that they are at a dance because they read about it in the DANCERgram.

SECRET HINTS FOR DANCING PEEL OFF

By Ed Foote

SECRET #1: THE CALL ALWAYS ENDS IN A LINE. The line may be facing in, or out, or it may be a two-faced line. So, if you always look for a line, this will help you be in the correct place.

HELPFUL HINT. The leaders always become the ends of the line, the trailers always become the centers of the line.

SECRET #2: THE LOCATION OF THE LINE IS HALF-WAY BETWEEN THE TOES OF THE TRAILING DANCERS AND THE HELLS OF THE LEAD DANCERS. This statement is true 90% of the time. (We will discuss the one exception dater.)

This is important to know, because many dancers simply say to themselves: "I have to turn away and take hands with someone." So they are sloppy in knowing where the ending line should be. Remembering Secret #2 enables the line to be formed quickly and precisely.

HOW TO IMPLEMENT SECRET #2: RULE: In your group of 4: the Leaders turn away and then step forward; the Trailers step forward then turn away. Following this rule will put you precisely where you belong. Obviously you must know whether you are a leader or a trailer.

EXCEPTION TO SECRET #2: The rule does not apply to a "Z" formation. (A "Z" formation is established by having a wave and the caller says: "Ends Fold.")

From a "Z", the Leaders turn away and remain in their same orientation – ie. They do NOT step forward. The Trailers do their normal "step forward and turn away." Ending formation: two-faced line.

At Plus you do not have to worry about this exception very much, because from a "Z" most callers will call Peel the Top. At Advanced and Challenge, Peel Off from a "Z" may be heard more frequently.

SECRET #3: DO THE CALL FAST. Reading the implementation of Secret #2, you may think that Peel Off has 2 parts. Not so. It is all one action.

The Callerlab definition says the time is 4 counts. This may true on paper, but it will hurt you to think of it this way. One reason people get in trouble with Peel Off is they do the call too slow – ie. They are just wandering around wondering where to stop. Well, Secret #2 tells you where to stop.

So, think of this call as one count. BAM! Turn and take hands immediately! Thinking in this manner will serve you well.
