## We Were Wrong

When DSL Promotions took over the publication of the <u>Zip Coder</u> in January of 2013, we thought the most difficult aspects of the task were improving the looks of the product, keeping track of subscriptions and maintaining a consistent publication schedule. We were wrong!

Utilizing the expertise of Express Press, improving the appearance of Zip Coder proved to be relatively easy — we just did our normal, day-to-day "thing." With the dedication and accounting skills that Rick and Sue Sylvester brought to the table, subscriptions, while not a piece of cake, was an orderly and highly regimented process which has worked perfectly. Maintaining a consistent production schedule was just a matter of discipline on the part of all four of us — something we were used to when running weekends and other special events in the square dance world.

So, what is the most difficult facet of publishing the <u>Zip Coder</u>? Believe it or not, it is getting articles to publish – <u>any articles</u>.

Typically, we have to scrape, beg and search for something which is worthy of publishing. In our opinion, this just should not be, given all the talent which exists in our square dance world. We have people in our hobby who have experience, ability, knowledge, ideas, involvement, understanding, etc. – plenty enough to produce an article – at least once a year.

Well, what does it take to write an article? Not much really – just think of a topic you are comfortable discussing and write about it. Don't be concerned with grammar, sentence structure, spelling, etc. – we will take care of that for you if needed. Your part is to decide on something you have some knowledge about and which may be of interest to the Advanced/Challenge Square Dance Community – then hop on your computer and bang out two, three or four pages (more if the subject warrants it). Send us the digital file and we will do the rest.

Okay, you ask, what kinds of subject matter is appropriate? It can be anything relevant to <u>Zip</u> <u>Coder</u> readers – for instance:

- Analyze a particular definition
- Tell a story about an event you attended
- Write about your favorite Advanced/Challenge Caller
- Promote a weekend which you think others would enjoy
- Explain how you decided to get into our activity
- Why do you stay in the activity
- Write some different choreography which others may enjoy
- How do you run your tape/computer group or workshop
- How have you handled a sensitive problem which arose
- Something humorous

- How you got someone interested in square dancing

- An interesting after-party
- Ways to improve our activity
- Anything which may be of interest to dancers or even non-dancers just interesting
