While we are on the subject of free advertising, are you taking advantage of our Florida Square Dance website? The website is <u>www.floridasquaredance.com</u>. You can do several things on this website;

- 1. If your club has a **website** that is currently separate from floridasquaredance.com, you can link your site to the Florida site. Just contact the webmaster for further details.
- 2. If you don't have a **website**, you can contact the webmaster (<u>brucemorgan@embarqmail.com</u>) and he will create a website for you at a very reasonable price. There are many inquiries made through the floridasquaredance.com website and we would hate for visitors to miss dancing at your club because you aren't listed on the website.
 - a. There is a **map program** on the website where you enter the information on your dance and it will mark the location on the map.
 - b. There is a **calendar program** where you can enter any of your dances and have your flyer attached.

Why not log onto floridasquaredance.com right now and see what all is included on this site. You will be pleasantly surprised!

Don't forget to utilize the West Coast *Dancer* newsletter which can only be found on the West Coast Association website. This publication also has an area for clubs to send in articles and another place to list your dance information by the day of the week. Again, all this is FREE!

And a plug for the DANCERgram! This publication is more detailed than the others. Each weekly issue contains the dance schedules for the upcoming week through Tuesday of the following week. Each club listing contains not only the name of the club or dance, it also includes the street address of the facility, name of the caller and/or cuer, dance level, preferred attire, theme (if applicable), and contact information. All the past issues are archived at <u>www.dancergram.com</u>. The newsletter is also broken down by sections and posted separately on the website. By checking the menu down the left side, you can jump right to what you are looking for. There is also a section on the website for square dance tours and cruises! This is a

weekly newsletter (magazine?) and due to the detailed information that is included in the What's Happening This Week... section, it is very important that the editor receives your information and is notified of any changes or cancellations. You can send your information for the whole year/season so you don't have to remember to send every week or month. If your club has an email distribution list of your members, please add the DANCERgram editor to the list. This way if something is changed or canceled, you won't have to contact the editor as the information will be relayed in your emails to your members.

There are also three other regional publications that you can utilize – *Panhandle Press, The Grapevine,* and *Hitchin' Post.* The submission due dates for these three publications are also listed in the DANCERgram. They all usually have an area to list dances and accept articles. Archived copies of these publications can be found at http://floridasquaredance.com/pubs.php. You will need to speak to each of the editors to determine if what their copy requirements are as well as the cost.

Poise

A word not often heard in today's lexicon and hardly ever mentioned in square or round dancing. The word, poise, may get a few raised eyebrows from those who consider poise only relegated to the ballroom dance world. Some folks may roll their eyes, as if to say: "here we go talking about some historic square dance oddity again". Friends, the term may not be engaging however the mechanics that define poise in square and round dancing is what creates dancers who are successful and stay in the activity longer. Poise has been part of my personal lesson plan in all programs for many years. In my opinion, it is more important to teach poise in a beginner's class than it is to teach extended applications or what some call "DBD". When poise and styling (dance technique) are part of learning a new call, dancers are better able to dance the calls without breakdowns. Anytime square breakdowns can be avoided, it will reduce frustrations (dancer and caller) and start to build the dancer's self confidence.

 Poise is control of your body's movements – the different between a good dancer and one who is bumping into others in the square, lagging behind the pace of calls, or just plain rough. In square dancing we teach "shuffle" steps, which is where your body weight is shifted forward over the balls of your feet. Heels rise off the floor and steps are made by sliding forward on the balls of your feet. Make sure that both feet are in constant contract with the ground. This adds stability. When someone is shuffling (sliding with both feet on the floor) it is difficult, if not impossible, to push them over. By contrast, a person simply walking lacks this stability and is very easy to push over.

The shuffle step in time with music has the forward slide on the downbeat of music, also known as the "boom". In shuffle rhythms where the beat is "boom, boom, boom, boom", the shuffle step should feel like a sliding march. Practicing this step can be done just by clapping your hands and shuffling forward on every clap. Clap fast and you won't keep in time with the beat for very long. The speed of clapping - the tempo being too fast is what causes dancers to stop shuffling and simply walk, out of time with the music. Callers who teach dancers how to shuffle, should also slow the music so they may enjoy shuffling.

Dancers should have hands at waist height and shoulders relaxed. Keep elbows pointed down and at their side, especially when dancing calls in ocean waves. When elbows come up, dancers build torque in their shoulder muscles and often, without realizing, are bearing down on the adjacent dancers. Sometimes the force is great enough to hurt adjacent dancers. When the elbows come up, dancers will find themselves reaching in front of them and often for the wrong dancers. As a caller, I see when dancers do "casting" calls like "Cast Off", "Spin The Top", "Relay The Ducey" and when elbows come up, dancers will reach out and grab anyone causing the square to break down. Finally, elbows up are a hazard to shorter dancers, where the risk is an elbow to the face from a dancer lacking control of their body movements.

2. Poise is physical balance – the different between being a good dancers and one who stumbles or falls in square. For many years we have taught dancers to stand up straight, sucking in their "dining room". This simple act allows dancers to not only look good, but also keep their square from breaking down. Aside from a physical disability that may preclude good posture, a dancer who slouches will not be able to properly executive "pull by" calls like ""Square Thru", "Right & Left Thru", etc. Their hands are too low because of poor posture, almost like they are dragging their knuckles on the ground. It is not lack of understanding the definition, it is lack of good dance posture that cause many breakdowns.

The first time many of the dancers in my beginner program hear me talk about dance posture is when the call, "Swing" is taught. A slouching dancer will not only incapable of smoothly executing the call, but will also fall behind causing the square to breakdown. During my years of calling, some of the most graceful "Swings" were executed by dancers in their 80's and 90's. They had learned physical balance and were too encumbered by the slowing down of aging.

At the same time, dancers are taught to "tuck in their sitting room", a polite way of saying "tightens their gluteal muscles" and this action keeps their feet directly under

their moving bodies. Sadly, we've seen the dancer who trips other dancers by getting their feet into another dancer's path or becomes tangled up in their own feet. This is more than not looking good, it is a hazard and one that can be corrected.

Becoming a dancer with poise is not accidental. It is learned and it is not difficult to learn. Poise is taught by the experienced caller, cuer, or dancers to help other dancers become smooth dancers. Poise and styling are the difference between being the dancer and others model themselves after versus someone who others may avoid.

Adding some thoughts to items in recent issues of American Square Dance Magazine:

1. **Caller Shortage**. A cartoon last fall showed a person reading a square dance publication and saying: "What we have is too many callers and not enough dancers." This is not necessarily true.

As I reported in this column in November, 2015, many areas of the country are reporting caller shortages. Naturally, fewer dancers results in fewer people being interested in trying calling, so the problem feeds on itself.

2. **Drinking and Dancing**. Last fall Buddy Weaver discussed drinking before and during dancing. While it is agreed that drinking and dancing do not mix, there is no interesting footnote to this.

Wisconsin has long been the home to a number of breweries. In the 1980s and 1990s it was common practice for square dance clubs to dance in bars. Many bars had a recreation hall, and they would let clubs dance for free in exchange for the people purchasing beer and liquor.

After every tip the dancers would go out to the bar and get a drink, come back and dance the next tip, then go get another drink, and so on throughout the evening. The amazing things was that all this drinking did not affect people's ability to square dance. They were able to do all the calls well, from Mainstream through Challenge. I called several dances at bars in Wisconsin.

The reason that drinking did not affect the dancing was that people from Wisonsin were so used to consuming alcohol. This is somewhat the same as people in France consuming large amounts of wine, and it does not affect them. But dancing in bars in Wisconsin faded out at the turn of the century, and it is not done today at all.

All this goes to show that there is often another side to an issue.

3. Yellow Rock. Last fall Buddy Weaver also discussed Yellow Rock, where dancers were expected to hug when this was called. But where did the term "Yellow Rock" come from?

Many years ago there was a barn in the suburbs of Kansas City called the Yellow Rock Barn. In the 1960s thru the 1980s square dance clubs would meet there. A local caller in the 1960s decided to label hugs as Yellow Rocks, in honor of the barn. I have called at this barn.

So now you know the rest of the story.
