Health and Sympathy



CALLERLAB Viewpoints

From "Bear" Miller

How Does "Bear" Make It Fun?

It begins with an attitude. These people, who have come to learn, are potential dancers who I will enjoy seeig at dances for years to come. They are new friends, not only for each other, but also for me! It is because I care! Next, I immediately tech them how it feels to be successfully dancing. I teach a couple of bigger moves on the very first night, like the Texas Star and Grand Square. That feeling of dancing is addictive and people want more! As I teach the smaller calls, I work on using good flow and up-tempo music so they continue to dance. I am continually using little helping words to contribute to the flow and to being successful.

Learning Styles

Try to remember that people learn differently, but most fall into one of the following categories. Attempt to touch all styles in some way.

- Auditory Learning occurs through hearing the spoken word.
- Kinesthetic Learning occurs through doing and interacting.
- Visual Learning occurs through looking at images, mind maps, demonstrations, and body language
- Tactile Learning occurs through writing notes and drawing diagrams.

I try to teach the concept of a call. Not only the definition, but also what the call accomplishes. Not just the boy's part or girl's part. I keep it light with funny ways to do things (boys put your hands behind your back, face your corner and Yellow Rock; make a right hand start with your thumbs; a Rat and Left Thru, etc.). I do end up picking on some individuals, but only after finding one who enjoys or asks for it!

Some Comments From My Current Students

- "You make square dance classes fun by your enthusiasm and your fun spirit. I like at the end of classes when you say, 'Goodnight' and offer some words of encouragement to each person. I really liked you emphasizing which calls were most important in all square dancing."
- "I like the sound effects you teach with certain calls Whoosh, Dude, and handclaps. I like the little extra words thrown in fore comic relief, e.g., 'Right and Left Thru, and turn Boo Boo, Lead Right, Dosado with Dynamite, etc."
- "I like the camaraderie and friends, but mostly the hugs."
- "The word of the week."
- "Pics of your grandson, Jiggle Up to the Middle and Back."
- "Picks on me unmercifully and I love it!"

- "Patient, non-threatening, assists and questions dancers having difficulties, lots of hugs."
- "The caller is a great teacher and notices everything and everybody. He repeats the calls to try and make sure you are at least on the right track."
- "Bear always makes class fun by keeping it light jokes, compliments, etc. The frustration level is low because he keeps the experience so positive."
- "The extra comments. Moving class along and keeping it challenging. Humor."
- "Great exercise. Great caller. Makes sure we know what we are doing before going on to another call. Makes things easy to learn."
- "Learning the concept of a call, not just the boy's part or girl's part. Don't take it too seriously - laugh at ourselves when necessary. Teaching the very "technical' aspects of a call – handholds in particular – makes us better dancers."
- "Lessons are great, instruction plan and easy to understand."
- "Bear makes this class fun and easy for the students. The goodnight circle is also fun and the students love it"

Little sayings can be found in Jon Jones' book (Square Dance Calling: Fill-in Patters or on Vic Ceder's website (www.ceder.net). Find something that works for you. Be innovative, poke fun at yourself, and find humor in daily life or something that happens during the lesson. Don't miss the chance for a smile!

So let's put some magic back into teaching.

To conclude as we began:

Fun is too important to not take seriously!

SHOW ME EDUCATION

The 67th National Square Dance Convention is fast approaching. Yes, you will want to dance! BUT...Have you considered the Education classes that are offered during the Convention? Classes are from 10:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M. SO...you do have time to dance, as most classes are only one hour long.

We will be offering the Leadership Certification Program (LCP) in Kansas City. The Leadership Certification Program is designed to help dancers become better leaders. It is intended to: 1) Enrich a Dancer's knowledge of relevant issues facing our pastime, 2) Provide information and tools to assist in promoting an interest in dancing, and 3) Suggest ideas and strategies to help deal with local club challenges.

To complete the Leadership Certification Program (LCP): 1) Pick up a LCP Worksheet at the Education Office in Room 2206. 2) Decide which sessions to attend. MANDATORY: BID SESSION AND KEYNOTE SPEAKER on FRIDAY MORNING plus Four Core Sessions and Two Elective Sessions. 3) Obtain signature from the room host to verify attendance. 4) Return worksheet to Room 2206. 5) Pick up your certificate form Room 2206 after 3:00 p.m. on Saturday. NOTE: The LCP may be completed in two consecutive years. If you choose this option, partially completed LCP worksheets must be returned to Room 2006.

If you invest two or three hours a day for three days, your dividends will include: a Certificate of Complete (suitable for framing) and Best of All...knowledge and materials useful for promoting, improving, supporting, sustaining, expanding, and perhaps saving your club!
