# USDA Square Dance Insurance Now Available for Caller-Run Clubs

For many years, the United Square Dancers of America (USDA) has made available to all square dancers a secondary Accident Medical Expense insurance plan; however, you must be a member of a USDA insured club to participate. It was announced at the last Federation meeting that caller-run clubs can also participate.

The following is a reprint of "Are You Dancing Uninsured?" USDA News Volume XXVIII, Issue 2 – April-June 2016"

"Every square dance organization needs General Liability and Accident Medical Expense coverage while conducting and sponsoring dance activities. As closely as safety rules are followed, accidents can and will happen. This insurance program, especially designed for USDA dance groups, provides Accident Medical insurance, which helps protect club members from financial loss due to a covered accidental bodily injury, and Liability insurance, which protects the club and its members and association officials from financial loss due to unforeseen incidents, which may develop into litigation against members and dance organizations.

#### LIABILITY INSURANCE

**Limits of protection**: \$1,000,000 combined single limit of liability for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence (subject to a \$100 property damage deductible per claim) while participating in scheduled and sponsored dancing activities, \$100,000 limit for damage to premises rented to you.

**Who is covered**: The club and its members while participating in club or organization sponsored and supervised dancing activities. Liability coverage applies in the United States, its territories or possessions, and Canada.

**Limits of coverage**: \$10,000 Usual and Customary Accident Medical Expense, including Dental \$10,000, Accidental Death Benefit \$10,000, Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of both hands, both feet, sight of both eyes, or any combination thereof), \$5,000 Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of one hand, one foot, sight of one eye). Note: Coverage is excess to any other valid and collectible medical insurance covering the same accident. Coverage provided for covered medical expenses incurred within 52 weeks of the accident up to \$10,000 for all eligible expenses as stated in the policy.

**Who is covered**: Club members will be insured while participating in any regularly scheduled and sponsored dancing activity worldwide, including group travel (10 or more club members) in a vehicle commercially licensed for transportation of passengers and operated by a person holding a valid operator license for such vehicle, while being transported to or from a covered dancing activity.

**What is covered**: Accidental bodily injury sustained by an insured person while participating in dancing activities sponsored and supervised by a recognized club or organization.

**Period of coverage**: The insurance year is January 1 through December 31. Coverage becomes effective for individual clubs under the policy on the day the application and premium for insurance is received by the USDA National Insurance Coordinator. There is no pro-rate provision. This is necessary due to the large administrative expense of maintaining different policy dates."

All clubs should consider taking advantage of this opportunity to protect the dancers as well as the club. Those clubs that have decided not to take advantage because their community covers them, should reconsider that decision. Consider this:

- 1. If your club does a one-nighter, a demo, or even entertains, your community will not cover you.
- 2. If you have members who do not live in your community but dance in your hall, they are not covered by your community.
- 3. If your club sponsors a class, the new dancers can also be covered free of charge.
- 4. Caller's insurance does not cover the dancers. This has been confirmed with CALLERLAB. The caller's insurance only covers him/her and his/her equipment.
- 5. If you dance in a government building and the dancers damage the facility in any way, your club will be responsible for the cost of repairing the damage. If you have USDA square dance insurance, you will also have liability insurance to cover these damages.
- 6. Some facilities will not rent or let you use their building without providing a Certificate of Insurance.

For a mere \$4.75 per dancer, you will have \$1,000,000 of General Liability and Accident Medical Expense coverage while conducting and sponsoring dance activities including Dental \$10,000, Accidental Death Benefit \$10,000, Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of both hands, both feet, sight of both eyes, or any combination thereof), \$5,000 Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of one hand, one foot, sight of one eye). Note: Coverage is excess to any other valid and collectible medical insurance covering he same accident. Coverage provided for covered medical expenses incurred within 52 weeks of the accident up to \$10,000 fore all eligible expenses as stated in the policy.

The entire club must participate. If anyone is insured through another square dance club in Florida, they are to be listed along with the name of the club they are insured with. You must have a minimum of eight dancers or a minimum of \$45 to submit your application. New members are added as they join the club no matter what of the year they join. The roster of new dancers in class is to be submitted at the beginning of class. The new dancers will be covered until graduation. They will then need to join a club that participates in the square dance insurance program so they have continued coverage.

# Henry Ford's Influence on Square Dancing

#### HENRY FORD AND BENJAMIN LOVETT

Excerpts taken from an article by Dave Taylor and published in a Square Dance Magazine in June 1980

In the year 1923 when Henry Ford visited the Wayside Inn in Sudbury, Massachusetts. This famous resort offered people who vacationed here dance instruction in the gavotte, the schottische, mazurkas, minuets, the Virginia Reel and square dancing. The teaching was under the leadership of Benjamin B. Lovett. Henry Ford enjoyed this program so much that he asked Benjamin Lovett to teach dancing and train dance instructors in Dearborn, Michigan. He offered Lovett a handsome salary and a two-month contract. Benjamin Lovett reluctantly turned down the offer, explaining that he was under contract to the Wayside Inn.

It should be noted here that at that time Henry Ford's personal wealth, exclusive of his automobile business and all other holdings, was in excess of twenty billion dollars. Therefore, Benjamin Lovett's obligations to the Wayside Inn posed no major problem to Mr. Ford. He simply purchased the Wayside Inn, met the terms of Benjamin Lovett's contract and renegotiated a new contract to bring him to Dearborn for two months. Benjamin Lovett stayed in Dearborn, Michigan, for 26 years.

At a time when the country was in the midst of a depression, Lovett was paid \$12,000 per year plus a new Lincoln every year, a home, most of his meals, and all of his travel expenses. He had substantial pay raises as the square dance program increased.

Once Benjamin Lovett was in Michigan, he and Mr. Ford began to publicize and promote early American square dancing. Two hundred dancing instructors from Ohio and Michigan were invited to Dearborn to learn how to dance and to call the Virginia Reel. Mr. Ford also directed Benjamin Lovett to begin a program for the Dearborn public school children.

Dances that Benjamin Lovett taught and called began to appear in newspapers around the country and included detailed instructions on how to execute these maneuvers. Mr. Ford also sponsored a radio program. Lovett would travel to Chicago every Sunday and call dances on the radio which had been printed in the newspapers during the previous week. This one-hour

program was broadcast from Chicago to the East Coast and after an hour wait to compensate for the time differential, the same broadcast was sent to the West Coast. Old fashioned square dancing became the rage.

As square dancing kept increasing, Mr. Lovett suggested that perhaps records would be another way of promoting the activity. Mr. Ford immediately contacted his good friend, Thomas Edison, and soon 78 rpm square dance records appeared on the Edison label.

# 64th FL Square and Round Dance Convention Update #1

#### February 23 – 24, 2017 The Ocean Center Daytona Beach, FL

A calming mist has settled over the enchanted forest as the wizards take a brief rest from the frenzy of the Convention Kickoff. There is so much to do; find a place for the trail end dance, get more hotels to give us discounts, tell Daytona that square & round dancers will be invading in February and we want discounts; but for now there is also time to dance. Our story began at the Kickoff for the 64th Convention, where we learned that the magic of dance will enchant you. Your squares will not break down, and round dancers will float gracefully as if on clouds. We also learned that Clarence the Misguided Magician had cast a carpet spell on the Lakeland center, causing it to grow luxurious carpeting from all of its floors. He thought that his spell was in keeping with the Convention theme, "The Magic of Dance Will Enchant You," but he discovered that dancers are not enchanted by carpet, even if it sings perfect harmony. Alas, Clarence was unable to undo the spell, and we had to find another place to dance. Convention Chair-Wizard Lewis stepped in, and, after consulting with Grand Wizard Google, he determined that the best place for the dance would be the Ocean Center at Daytona Beach. Unfortunately, Clarence had already visited the Ocean Center as well. In fact, he has been very busy throughout Florida, and it is impossible to find a large enough dance hall with a decent dance floor. Chair-wizard Lewis agreed to plant some trees in the Enchanted Forest so that the dancers would have a nice wood floor to dance on. Registration Wizard Dennis Taylor consulted the Magic Mirror to find out how many dancers there would be, but the Mirror was hazy on the subject, so we depend on the dancers to register early, so we know how much floor we will need. To encourage early registration, we are keeping the early-bird price of \$35 through May.

In case you missed our kickoff, there are a number of new features on the way for 2018. Foremost is the Daytona Ocean Center, a modern facility on Daytona Beach, surrounded by restaurants, attractions, and, of course, the beach. Our intrepid web-wizard, Bruce Morgan has posted a brief video about Daytona Beach and the Ocean Center at the Convention website:

120 people registered at the Convention this year, which means that if you have not registered yet, 120 people have the jump on you in getting their Dance Passports signed off. Dance Passports are a new feature for 2018. Every person who registers for the Convention gets a Passport. You bring it with you all year, and have it dated and initialled every time you dance. Then bring it with you to the Convention, and we will award prizes for the most nights danced, the most clubs or events visited, and some random drawings for prizes. Be sure to turn in your passport at the registration desk on Friday. If you know you will be unable to attend the convention, we will give you a passport for a donation of \$5, so you can play too. The best way to get lots of sign-ins is to register early and get started! Dance Passports are not valid for international travel. Clarence the Misguided Magician offered to enchant all of the Dance Passports so that they would make a loud buzzing sound if they were left behind when their owner went dancing, but the Ways and Means wizards admonished him that it would only be annoying. Anyway, people will want to keep their passports handy because of all the great prizes.

The other thing that we are really excited about is our Blast Class. Why a blast class? The blast class is our answer to an early-in-the-year convention. We would not want to all go off to the convention and tell our new students "you can't come to the party this year because you don't know enough." That would be awful. So a blast class is for our new students to come join the fun. In California, they had 4 squares of students and one square of newbies off the street. We need new approaches to introduce square dancing to our friends. Bob Ormsbee and Keith Stevens will give our new dancers a great experience. We want them to come for a weekend, and stay for a lifetime! Please invite your friends to join you for a wonderful weekend. Please post the invitation for the blast class on your social media. It is the same cost as the convention.

We would like to thank all of you who attended our kickoff at the 63rd Convention. We appreciate your support, and we hope that it was fun and informative. We also acknowledge Keith Stevens and the Flowing Figures, who provided the dance number at the beginning, and we would like to give a special thank-you to Keith and Angie Olds, who did such a great job creating the book of Our Story.
