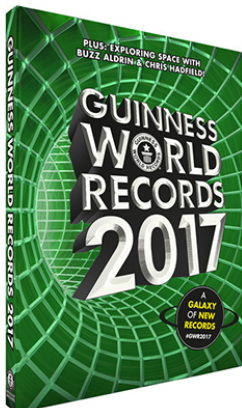
The Time is Now, the 66th NSDC is Upon Us

The convention center, hotels, tour operators, restaurants, and all the committee volunteers are all putting the finishing touches on the 4 year long plan. The callers & cuers, entertainers, and the tours are all scheduled down to the minute. All we need now is for all our friends from around the world to arrive and enjoy Cincinnati's

"A Great American Experience"

We are very fortunate to have such a great location for our convention. There are literally hundreds of places to see and so many things to do in the greater Cincinnati area. Please

take an extra bit of time to check out things on the way in and out of the convention.

Every convention has its sweet spot and I think you will agree that ours is our **compact location**. By compact I do not mean small, I mean close and convenient. The convention center and hotels are all within two blocks. Over 1000 rooms are across the street. You will not need to purchase a bus pass unless you are a camper. You may want to share a room, or carpool. You may want to pack your cooler with lunch and save some money for a tour or any number of other opportunities. The point I am making is register and come and enjoy the largest event of the year. Visit those friends you have met in years past. Make this your first National or the first time to dance with the Ghost Riders Band. We have tried to plan something for everyone, and it is up to you to sign up and be part of the fun.

We still have hotels to fill so keep sending in your housing request. All the hotels with open rooms are still some of the best. Also keep in mind that we still have a few camping spots available for those that like to stay out a bit and drive in or ride the bus.

The Guinness Book of World Record attempt for the **Largest Square Dance in the World** will be on Saturday afternoon. Follow the group down to Fountain Square afterward to celebrate the record and dance for the News people.

Need a dance partner? We have a mixer dance on Thursday morning for just that reason. There will be a lunch event following as well. Pick up the "Ask Me to Dance Ribbon" if you like at the registration desk. This can help in finding a person to dance with.

We have some of the **best Round Dance halls** with large wood floors that you will find anywhere. The best cuers and round dance teachers in the country are scheduled this year. The Roundalab convention is in our host hotel this year so they will all be here too.

Want to learn something every day? There is a free Caller school, Sew & Save projects, Leadership Certification Program, Seminars & Panels and much more.
