
Health and Sympathy

Dear ARTS,

We've all been trying to spread the word about ARTS-DANCE for quite some time, but when I ask people now, if they know what ARTS is, I swear, hardly any of them know what I'm talking about. I really think we need to tell them again just who makes up the ARTS-DANCE organization and what our common goal is.

A Current ARTS-DANCE Member

Dear Current,

Thank you for your support. I agree with you. Informing current dancers about the ARTS-DANCE mission is a gargantuan task, and, lots of folks have yet to get this important message.

ARTS-DANCE stands for Alliance of Round, Traditional, and Square Dance, and combines ten organizations whose goal is to bring new dancers into the activity. ARTS member organizations are; All Join Hands, CALLERLAB, CONTRALAB, International Association of Gay Square Dance Clubs (IAGSDC), National Square Dance Campers Association (NSDCA), National Square Dance Convention Executive Committee (NEC), ROUNDALAB, Single Square Dancers USA (SSDUSA), United Square Dancers of America (USDA), and USAWest Square Dance Convention Policy Board (USAWest).

The ARTS mission is to generate public awareness and promote growth and acceptance of contemporary Square, Round and Traditional Folk Dance by encouraging and assisting a coalition of allied dance groups. The ARTS will provide leadership and resources necessary to create an achievable marketing program. The ARTS will encourage, promote and support healthy lifestyles through dance programs and events that provide fun and effective exercise for both mind and body, all within a unique system of social interaction.

We have one annual meeting with all individuals paying their own airfare, hotel and meals. An action plan is established, however, the goal of 50,000 new dancers can only become reality if we have the backing and help of many more of our current dancers.

Our operating funds come from donations. We encourage Individual Memberships with a donation of \$25.00/person. We also offer Associate Membership to organizations with a

donation of \$100.00. We have also established a "\$100 Club" with the goal of 1,000 Members. Meeting this goal will provide a very large fund of \$100,000 for regional and possible national promotion.

We have accomplished much over the past few years including: 1) Established an Education Grant Program, 2) Helped fund Square Dancing 101 and Contra 101, 3) Created the online information web site <u>www.You2Candance.org</u> 4) Funded promotion of the Live Lively Re-Image Project, 5) Creation of the ARTS web site <u>www.ARTS-Dance.org</u> 6) Provided support to National Square Dance Conventions and USAWest Conventions, 7) Created an electronic information distribution system, and others.

Summer is heating up in the Enchanted Forest, and the gnomes have been doing their best to calm down the dragons so they won't make as much heat. The saplings planted for the Convention's wood floor are growing well, and they have gotten their bark as well as their bite!

We would like to tell you about a new feature that your Ways and Means wizards will be bringing around soon. Wish trees are a Japanese tradition where people write their wishes on paper or wood and hang them from trees or wire forms resembling trees. I can't tell you how often the wishes come true, but I can say for sure that when you buy a wish, it will help our dreams of a great Convention come true by helping to pay for the flooring. We will have colorful paper and other materials to choose from, and you can decorate them any way you fancy. Make a wish, say Hi to that special someone, or share whatever philosophy happens to move you at the moment. Put anything you want (that would not be bleeped on broadcast TV) on the card, and we will display it for the duration of the Convention. The class is intended for people who are completely new to square dance, and for people who are already taking lessons. The goal will be to teach about half of the mainstream program, but the focus will be on a fun weekend and a chance for learners to get some good floor time.

In the past, there was really nothing for people to do at a Convention until they had completed Mainstream classes. This class will give your friends a chance to experience the fun of dance as well as the fellowship and excitement of a whole convention of dancers. Please let your non-dancer friends know about this opportunity, and please ask your caller to announce it when your fall or winter square dance classes begin. Also, at the Convention, please stop by the class from time to time to be angels. Ribbons for Blast Class students will be \$35 no matter when they register.

Lastly, I have a few words about the dress code. Some folks have actually asked me what "clothing required" means. Many of us love getting all gussied up in our Square-Dance Finest. Nothing beats the sight of folks in their fancy outfits, skirts whipping and bolos flying. And some folks are a little put off by it. Wizard Linda and I frequently go out in square dance outfits, and never, not once, ever, has anybody told us "I just have to learn to square dance so I can dress up like that too!" So, what kind of clothing is required, you might ask. Go ahead, I'm listening.

Funny you should ask, because I actually have several answers for that: Dress as you wish to be remembered. You will be dancing with 6 or 7 hundred of your best friends, and they will remember. If you would wear it to the shopping mall, you can wear it here. If you would wear it to the gym, maybe not. Most important, don't let clothing choices be a problem. Be comfortable. Be stylish. Be outrageous. Be traditional. Be unique. Be whatever makes this the best Convention that it can be for you! Any questions?
