

Are You Working for or Against Us?

What an odd title! What's that mean "are we working against each other"? When I hear people promoting only their club or only their lessons, the hair on the back of my neck just stands up and my blood pressure jumps just a few points.

When we are struggling so hard to keep our clubs running, to recruit dancers to our classes, just to recruit more dancers period, why would we be so narrow minded as to not promote square dancing as a whole?

When you are talking to anyone (young or old, married or single) about square dancing and the night of your club dance or class doesn't fit their schedule, don't stop talking. Keep talking and let them know there are dances and/or classes on other nights and tell them what they are and when they are. So, what if you are putting people in someone else's club or class; you're getting us more dancers!

Don't rush new dancers into club membership before they have "graduated" from a class so that you "get them first" before they join another club. If you are truly practicing what you preach, that you are a friendly club and a fun place to dance, they will want to join without you pressuring them into it.

I know that a lot of you have shirts, jackets and caps that reference square dancing. How many of you wear them to other places other than dances or dance related activities? You have no idea how many times I get questions when I wear my jacket with the huge square dance logo on the back of it.

When you schedule your classes, are you paying attention to what is going on in your area? Who else is having classes? What day and time of day are they having their classes? Do you make any attempt to schedule your class so that it doesn't conflict with other classes in close proximity to yours? When classes in the same area are on the same night, new dancers are unable to attend more than once class if they want to. I always encourage new dancers to try to attend more than one class; this will help them better. Please be considerate when scheduling your classes so they don't conflict with other classes in your area.

We have to stop with this mentality of "we have to get dancers for our club and not worry about the activity as a whole."

Do you tell Singles they can't come unless they bring a partner? Do you cancel a class because you have too many single women?

So back to the question, "Are we working against each other?" when we only recruit for our club and/or classes, when we are selective about who we recruit, when we "compete" with another club or class to gain participants, when a select few are out there constantly promoting the activity and the rest of the group is just sitting back complaining about how we are losing dancers, that we have tried everything, that won't participate in banner raids or visit other clubs and festivals/conventions?

It's time for everyone to step up and promote the ACTIVITY! When you are talking to anyone about square and round dancing, be knowledgeable about what is going on in your area and provide them with all the information. Always make visitors and solos welcome when they show up at your dances. Just because you have a greeter at the door doesn't make you a friendly club if all your members sit in their little groups and don't talk to these dancers, don't include them in your squares, etc. Attend the classes in your area and angel these new dancers, even if your club isn't sponsoring the class or you don't belong to a club. They need all the help they can get so they can learn faster and get out on the dance floor sooner.

What are you doing – working against us or with us?

Ask Not What Your Square Dance Club Can Do for You Ask What You Can Do for Your Square Dance Club!

You can help in the following ways:

1. Belong to a square dance club 2. Come to club dances as often as you can 3. Bring refreshments 4. Come early to help set up the hall 5. Stay late to help clean up the hall 6. Be friendly and be sure to greet all visitors 7. Come to all dances and all classes clean and wearing fresh-smelling clothes 8. Attend banner activities as often as you can 9. Tell your friends and acquaintances of the fun we have square dancing 10. Recruit new students 11. Angel the class of new students 12. Be patient, pleasant and polite when you get into a square that keeps breaking down 13. Take a turn serving on the Board and/or on committees 14. Escort others to the parking lot so no ladies go out alone 15. Try to include everyone. Make sure no one ever comes to a dance and sits all evening without being asked to dance.

Square Dancers Are the Friendliest People You Will Ever Meet

How many times have you seen, heard, or used the phrase "square dancers are the friendliest people you'll ever meet" to promote square dancing? I know I have used it many times but recently I have heard or witnessed things that make me doubt this statement as it relates to square and round dancers.

The Merriam-Webster online dictionary defines "friendliest" as : of, relating to, or befitting a friend: such as: showing kindly interest and goodwill < friendly neighbors>b: not hostile < a friendly merger offer>; also: involving or coming from actions of one's own forces < friendly fire>. The Merriam-Webster online dictionary also defines "friend" as: 1a: one attached to another by affection or esteem < She's my best friend.>b: ACQUAINTANCE, 2a: one that is not hostile < Is he a friend or an enemy?>b: one that is of the same nation, party, or group < showbiz friends>, 3: a favored companion.

I ask you, how friendly is it when

- ♥ a person of another ethnic group from yours is shunned?
- ▼ a person of another sexual orientation than yours is shunned?
- ▼ a young person is shunned or disrespected because they don't do things the way you
 do?
- a person is shunned because their religion or beliefs may be different than yours?
- someone is "talked over" because you have a loud booming voice?
- a new dancer is told they can't serve on a committee because they don't know anything about the task(s) of the committee?
- a new dancer(s) makes a recommendation and they are told "we've tried that and it didn't work" (so we don't need to try it again)?
- ◆ dancers are not included in a square because they dance with flourishes¹ or you consider them too loud?
- a person with a developmental or physical handicap is avoided?
- same-sex couples, whether they are gay/lesbian or not, are excluded from squares or told that men should be dancing the man's part and women should be dancing the woman's part?
- ▼ a club specifically states that in order to join a club you have to be a male/female couple; in other words, no singles, no gays/lesbians?
- singles/solos (never married, divorced, widowed, dancing solo due to spouse/partner not being able to dance) are not included when forming squares, making plans to go out to eat, visiting other clubs, travel, etc.?

I ask you again, "how can we say we are the friendliest people you'll ever meet?" when people are treated like this? It sounds like false advertising to me.

Are You Part of the Problem or Are You Part of the Solution?

What does that mean?

Do you complain about everything square dance related? Do you have fresh ideas?

Instead of complaining, why don't you start attending your Association meetings and the meetings of the Florida Federation and let your concerns be known? These are not closed meetings and everyone is invited and encouraged to attend them. Don't just attend a meeting to complain and then we never see you again. If you think you have solutions or ideas that would work, you need to come to these meetings and get involved in resolving whatever the problems are.

If you attend these meetings, you may find that we are already attempting to work on resolving many of the problems. Since you haven't been attending these meetings, you don't know that we may have been testing something and it didn't work or we have made some changes that did work.

You don't know that we have Convention Guidelines to abide by which are endorsed by the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, the Florida Callers Association, and the Round Dance Council of Florida. If any changes are made to these guidelines, they have to be approved by two out of three of these state organizations.

You don't know that we keep the convention in central Florida as it is central to all the dancers in the state. Our Guidelines state that the convention location has to be within 100 miles of the I-4 corridor in order to have easy accessibility for all the dancers in Florida. We have researched all the major convention centers in Central Florida and found that the Lakeland Center is the cheapest plus it is the only convention center that isn't carpeted.

You don't know that once you get on the "list" to book the Lakeland Center, you better stay on the list or you won't be able to get back on for another several years. I am sure this is the same with any convention center in the state of Florida. Also, by working with the same location year

after year, you build a relationship with the staff which can be instrumental in making arrangements and renting space.

You don't know that we can't just move a three day convention to the winter months to accommodate the snow birds. We attempted to move into the slot held by the Sunshine Festival (January) when they shut down, but someone heard about the availability first and grabbed that weekend before we even knew it was available. Now that we are testing a two-day convention, we may be able to do something but we have to wait and see what everyone thinks about the two-day convention.

The Florida Federation represents all the dancers of Florida and we can't operate with a narrow mind and tunnel vision when attempting to come up with solutions. We have to consider accessibility, are there other weekend festivals to schedule around, etc.? This is why we have representatives from each of the five regional Associations on the Federation Board. If we book the convention the same month as say the Shamrock Swing, people will only go to one of the events so then someone suffers a financial loss.

The next time you want to complain about something, think about "what can I do to resolve the problem"; find out what is causing the problem or why something is done the way it is done. There may be a valid reason for the way things are currently being done. Don't complain just to complain; have a solution.

Along the same lines; if you are currently participating with a club in their banner raids/retrievals, wearing their club colors, etc. why can't you pay a few bucks and become an "official" member? It never fails that the people who complain that we don't need to have refreshments are always the first ones to the table to fill their plate (many times more than once). The people that say they don't want to join a club because they don't want to have to work. But if we all had that attitude, there wouldn't be anyone to set up the hall for a dance, contract the callers and cuers, pay the callers and cuers, and make the coffee. There wouldn't be a dance!

We all need to pull together in order to keep dancing alive. Where can you help?

Square Dance Manners

In square dancing we all have a wonderful opportunity to meet new people and to get to know these people more than just casually. We have a wonderful time dancing with these people and talking with them.

Many times, making a new friend or keeping an old one depends on our actions as well as our talk. Here are a few helpful hints that, if practiced by all of us, will make our growing square dance family a much better one.

- 1. I will make it a practice to meet at least one new couple at each dance.
- 2. I will never sit out a dance if one couple is needed to fill up a square. [The universal signal that dancers are needed on the floor is unison clapping until the open positions are filled.)
- 3. I will serve on refreshment committees and fulfill all my club obligations. (We get out of a club what we put into it.)
- 4. I will try to always have a good time at dances and always be nice to other dancers.
- 5. I will never blame a mistake on other dancers or hold a grudge if one is made.
- 6. I will always applaud at the end of a tip. (Not necessarily for the caller but for the other dancers in my square).
- 7. I will leave the instruction to the caller and not try to teach my own square.
- 8. I will remember that personal grooming is important to my acceptance in a square dance group [this means taking care of bad breath].
- 9. I will skip the after dinner toddy or any other forms of intoxicating drinks until after the dance.
- 10. I will always be glad to dance with a less experienced dancer. (We were all beginners once.)
- 11. I will always thank the other dancers in my square at the end of a tip.
- 12. I will always try to dance with as many different couples as possible in an evening of dance.
- 13. I will always discourage cliques; try to be friendly with everyone.
- 14. If a square appears to be a couple short but there are no fingers in the air, I will ask if the square is made up before entering that square to dance.
- 15. It is common courtesy to thank the caller at the end of an evening of dancing.
- 16. I will never walk out of a square before the end of a tip.
- 17. I will leave bracelets and rings at home so I won't cut other dancers as we are dancing.
- 18. I will always be mindful of safety practices.
- 19. I will never walk through a square to get to another square. I will always take the first available opening.
- 20. I will not participate in a "stacked" square (the square is formed prior to going on to the dance floor and always dancing with the same people).

We all square dance for fun. Let's leave our personal disagreements and grudges at home and have a good time.
