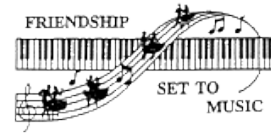

One more time around the race track and head for the open door! Have you bought your ribbon? See the details at the end of this article for purchase information. The 65th Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention is going to be a weekend full of fun! After all, NASCAR means “Navigate Awesome Squares and Cruise through Amazing Rounds.”

The dancing starts at 10 AM on Friday, Feb. 22. You can dance 10:00-noon, 1 – 4PM, and 6:30 - 9:30 (or 10:00, TBD) PM Friday and Saturday. Workshops will be held in the mornings, including Introduction to Hex Dancing. Friday evening the Florida Four will perform (Scotty Sharrer, Sam Dunn, Ernie Rollen, and Alan Snell). Saturday morning there will be dancing on the beach at 8:00 AM with callers Bill Boyd and Mark Fetzer. You’ll get to try dancing with no hands and with a rubber band. (I’m not sure how that works!) Also on Saturday morning a sewing class will be held by the Two Terrys (learn how to make a stained glass jacket!). There are Dangle Dances at 1:00 PM Saturday afternoon with callers Bill Boyd and Ernie Rollen. (Don’t miss the Dangle Dances because Judy Anderson is in charge, and she is a HOOT. She has planned Car Racing, Mutual Betting, Horse Racing, and more). Callers Ron Libby and Bobby Keefe will dazzle us Saturday evening. In the afternoons you can experience a new feature for the Florida Convention, Rounds by Request. And for all you C1 Dancers, C1 is on the agenda.

Awarding the Best!

Volunteers in square and round dancing are paid such handsome salaries that there is no need to say thank you or to recognize them for their hard work, the many miles they put on their cars to visit your clubs/special dances and attend meetings, the toner and paper they use to print off flyers and newsletters, their time to come to the dance early to set up and stay late to clean up, to be at the classes to angel, etc.

You hear the names of some volunteers all the time and others you never know their name; some have danced for many years and others are new dancers. If it weren't for our volunteer workers, there wouldn't be any dances because you wouldn't have anyone to advertise, set up and clean up at the dance or recruit new dancers. Many times, we get busy and forget to even say thank you to those many people who work to make our activity possible. Have we lost some dancers because they have worked so hard and they didn't feel appreciated?

Let's talk about the various forms of recognition/thank you available in square and round dancing.

A simple “thank you” can always be done on the spur of the moment and requires no prior planning. At the dances we want to be sure to thank all the members who help set up for the dance, who greeted, who set up refreshments, and who will help clean up after the dance. We also want to thank the dancers for coming to the dance, as well as the caller, cuer and their spouses/partners. If there are any “VIPs” in attendance, i.e. other callers/cuers (and their spouses/partners), West Coast Officers, Federation Officers, United Square Dancers of America. National and State Convention officers, County Reps, other Association officers, anyone along these lines, they should be recognized. Consider introducing these guests at the beginning of the dance so that everyone has a chance to greet them during the evening.

Below are the awards that are available along with the guidelines, nominating procedures and the nomination deadlines. As you read through them, is there anyone you can think of that should be nominated for any of them?

Circle of Service – The Circle of Service was the brainchild of Mori Sogolow of Strawberry Square in Plant City, Florida, during the spring of 1985. Mori, who at that time had been asked to be a moderator of a LEGACY panel on Awards and Recognition, conferred with Chet Vetter, also of Strawberry Square in Plant City, Florida, who at the time was chairman of LEGACY’s leadership and education committee and coordinator of Legacy Panels to the National Convention to be held in June 1985 in Birmingham, Alabama. The original title of the circle was “Wheel of Progress”, but while Kit Waldorf of Pensacola, Florida, who was asked to design the emblem, was completing her artistic enterprise, the title was changed to the “Circle of Service”. The new title, together with Kit Waldorf’s original design was more than acceptable and ready for presentation by Legacy in June 1985.

This award for DANCERS ONLY was introduced to the panel on awards and recognition conducted by Legacy at the 34th National Convention held in Birmingham, Alabama in June 1985. The “Circle of Service” presentation was acted upon with favor, being made part of the Square & Round Dancing activities by the committee.

Those initially receiving this honor at the Panel meeting were: Brock and Mary Brockwell, vice chairman of panels at Birmingham; Bob and Dottie Elgin, chairman of Legacy from Pennsylvania. The following day at the Legacy Board meeting, Don and Mary Martin of Georgia, Ernie and Barbara Stone of Indiana, Bill and Colleen Wilton of Wisconsin, Gordon Goss and Partner Valarie of Mississippi, Vivian McCannon of Texas and Vera Chestnut of Wisconsin were all presented the “Circle of Service”.

The citation accompanying the presentation reads: This circle is a symbol of service to Square and Round Dancing. It is designed to be worn with PRIDE by dancers who, for three or more years are determined to have made a significant contribution to the Square and Round Dance movement.

The stellar hub of the Circle, formed by a pattern of ARCS, symbolizes the importance of each such an individual to the total picture. The same circular shapes flow outward to help define interlocking squares and stylized musical symbols. This linear interplay suggests the strong bond between the two “sister” dance activities, Square and Round Dancing.

A certificate and a small dangle are presented to each recipient. This award must be presented by someone who has already received the Circle of Service award. The dangle can be purchased from any badge vendor.

West Coast Association President’s Choice Award – This award is presented by the current West Coast President at either the President’s Ball or at the Annual Fall Fun Fest. A deserving square or round dance couple or single is selected by the president(s) for extraordinary effort in promoting Square and Round Dancing in cooperation with the West Coast Square and Round Dancers’ Association. An engraved plaque is presented to the recipient(s).

West Coast Association Distinguished Service Award¹ – The purpose of this award is to recognize a member(s) of the West Coast Square & Round Dancers’ Association (WCSRDA) who has given service to the (WCSRDA) above and beyond the average dancer. The committee shall consist of the five most recent recipients of the award. Each year a new member will come on and the longest serving will resign (unless someone else has to resign). They will elect a chairman from within. A quorum, a simple majority, is required to transact any business. This committee will review all nominations and select a winner by vote of the majority attending the meeting. The recipient(s) will not be revealed until the presentation. Any WCSRDA member may make nominations.

Nominations will be submitted in the form of a resume. The resume shall include, but not be limited to: (1) number of years dancing; (2) number of years member of WCSRDA; (3) club membership; (4) offices held or holding at all levels. List the special contributions which you believe qualifies the nominee for the award.

Nominations shall be submitted no later than October 15th² of each year. The award (an engraved plaque) will be presented annually at the Fall Fun Fest.

Extra Mile Award - The purpose of this award is to show appreciation to both Callers and Cuers who go beyond the norm in giving freely of their time and talents to the square and round dance activity. The criteria for the award is that the caller or cuer be a member of the Florida Callers Association or the Round Dance Council of Florida.

² The due date used to be July 20th. It was changed in 2018 to October 15th.

The procedure for nomination is (1) the Board of the Florida Federation shall be the selection committee, with the current president as chairman of same. New members coming on will replace one going off; (2) any dancer may submit a name of a caller/cuer to the selection committee prior to December 1st of the year in which the nominee is to be selected. The nomination should include a brief autobiographical sketch and at least three (3) events at which the caller/cuer has demonstrated his or her contribution to the square dance activity; (3) the selection committee to meet during the February working weekend to review the nominee(s) and arrive at a final decision. UPDATE: It was just announced at the Federation Meeting that a nomination form has been created and it will be posted on the Florida Federation website. The nominations should be submitted to the Federation secretary. The award(s) should be presented at the following Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention by the current president of the Florida Federation. The award(s) presented shall be a framed document and an "Extra Mile Award Recipient" bar or dangle.

Hall of Fame - Nominees must have a minimum of 10 years statewide involvement in the Florida Square and Round Dance activity. Their contributions must encompass the entire state of Florida, not just one or two areas. This should require unselfish dedication of time and labor. Being an Area president, Federation president, Caller/Cuer Association president and/or State Convention chairman is not enough. The Hall of Fame is seeking individuals or couples whose efforts have affected the majority of the State of Florida. The fact that one is nominated is a very high honor, whether or not they enter the Hall of Fame.

Preparing a nominating resume will take some time and investigation to make it complete. Talk to other dancers, callers and/or cuers for dates, places and times the nominee was involved in statewide participation. Follow the who, what, when and where rules as you investigate and prepare the resume. The more information submitted, the better.

The Resume Outline contains the following information: Nominee Name(s), Full Address, Phone Number, Email, Began Dancing-Year, What Dance Club(s) do they belong to, Held Club Office(s) & Dates, Member of which State Association(s), Office(s) Held & Dates, Please explain what the Nominee(s) has done using this format: Who (Names), What (They did [This can be done in resume form or as a story], When – Dates [IF the exact date is not available please give the year], Where – Area of the State.

Once the résumé(s) is finished there are two ways in which to present the information to the Hall of Fame Committee. The resume(s) may be submitted to the Board of Directors of any of the Five Associations, Callers Association or Cuers Association. The Area or Association Board of Directors will review the resume(s) and vote to reject or pass it on to the Hall of Fame Committee chairman. The resume(s) must be received by the Hall of Fame Committee by January 15th of each year. It is suggested that any association not submit more than two resumes for consideration per year. The Hall of Fame Committee shall meet and review all resume(s) presented and vote by secret ballot before forwarding such resume(s) to the Selection Committee for the final vote.

ROUNDALAB – COPYRIGHTS AND ETHICS

During this past year ROUNDALAB has been presented some items for consideration. These concerns involve the ethical behavior of a few of our members. This is a topic that our Board of Directors need to be shared with our entire membership.

Our educational materials (standards, manuals, videos, etc.) are all copyrighted materials. These items are ROUNDALAB property and are provided for our members knowledge and personal use. Our ROUNDALAB materials are there for the benefit of our members. The years of volunteer time and effort put into the creation of these materials was donated by each and every member of ROUNDALAB whom have served on a committee. We do provide a way for non-members to obtain many of our materials. This is through a subscription program or purchasing the items.

The ethics issues that have arisen are:

1. Our videos are being given away by someone who had purchased the items. They were making copies and telling the person receiving these videos, ROUNDALAB was giving them away. This is not true. Without the income from the sales of these videos ROUNDALAB would not be able to go back into the studio to film new figures, film figure updates, or create new products Our videos are available through our on-line catalog or the ROUNDALAB office.
2. Our Manuals (e.g. Teaching Progression, Manual for New round Dance Leaders, etc.) were being printed and given away. These manuals can be purchased through the office if you wish to provide a non-member a physical copy. It is through these purchases we help to defray the expenses from the committee and some office costs. Please do not print and give away any of our manuals.
3. Our Standards manuals were being printed and given to dancers. Again, these are available to our members through our website. Dancers can be directed to go to our web-page catalog or call the office to purchase a subscription.
4. Members have been posting our ROUNDALAB manuals onto their own websites. Members are encouraged to download these manuals to their computer for their personal use, but they should not post them to theirs or other's sites.
5. Members are sharing their ROUNDALAB website passcode with nonmembers. These passcodes are for members use only. It gives our members access to all our manuals and materials we have published online. As stated in #2 & #3 above these materials are available in our on-line catalog or through the ROUNDALAB office.
6. Members have been giving away digital copies of music. We all must strive to won each piece of music we use. If you want to "share" a piece of music, purchase a copy and

through the website (Amazon, iTunes, etc. “gift” the music within the purchasing process. Please look at the Gild Of Pride (www.guildofpride.org) for information on why we should own our own copy of music.

7. We have some members using other leaders recorded cues for dances and events without the cuers permission for use. Please get permission from a leader if you are wanting to use their recorded cueing skills at your events.

Each of the above items involve a poor choice of behavior. Many of the above items cut into the income of ROUNDALAB. By giving away these items you are making it more difficult for ROUNDALAB to cover the costs of the upkeep of these items and the creation of new items.

And remember, all Round Dance leaders working within the United States should have a license from ASCAP, BMI, and SESAC before performing music in a public venue (a dance is a public venue). If there is a leader in your area who is not a member of ROUNDALAB, please encourage them to reach out to our office and take the steps needed to join our organization. By doing so, they will have access to the items I spoke of above, all three music performance licenses, and the support and camaraderie of our ROUNDLAB members.
