West Coast Association President's Message

It's hard to believe we are almost at the end of 2019 already! Here it is, the first of December. Are you ready for Christmas? I'm not. I haven't even

started!

There are several classes in session now, and more will be starting in January. What are you doing to recruit new dancers? Everyone needs to work on this. It's not the responsibility of the officers or the class coordinator. Don't just tell them about it; offer to pick them up and go to the class with them.

Our Fall Fun Fest in November was a success! We made over \$1,500 profit. What can we do to make it better next year? If you have any ideas, I'd like to discuss them with you. The 2020 Fall Fun Fest will be November $13^{th} - 14^{th}$ and will again be at the Carver Recreation Center in Bartow. The staff includes Ted Kennedy (Alabama), Jack Lewis (southeast Florida), and Earle and Carol Collins (Cuers). If every couple that was at the 2019 Festival brought a new couple to the 2020 event, we would double the attendance.

We're almost to the wire for the 2020 Florida State Convention in Daytona Beach, February 21^{st} – 22^{nd} . The price of ribbons increases January 1^{st} , so if you want to save some money, better purchase your ribbons now. There are several fundraising items and Gold Sponsor buttons available. You'll want to have one of these. This button gets you into the Trail End Dance for FREE. Gold Star members will be listed in the convention program book. Convention representatives are trying to attend all the big dances as well as the local dances to bring these items to you. In the West Coast Association area, Jenny Green and I can help you with your orders.

Don't forget to make your hotel reservations too. The Homewood Suites is the host hotel, and you'll want to take advantage of the square dance rate, so don't delay!

Have you renewed your membership in the West Coast Association? The 2020 membership bars are available, and you can either join or renew with any of the county reps and most of the officers. The initial membership fee is \$12 per person; this includes your engraved name badge. Renewals are \$6 per person.

The purpose of the West Coast Association is to (1) promote the expansion of square and round dancing in our area by informing the general public of the healthful recreational opportunities in square and round dancing, (2) promote an active fellowship among dancers through demonstrations, open dances, publicity, training programs, etc., (3) encourage the formation of more square and round dance lessons and clubs, and (4) bring about a spirit of cooperation among the callers, cuers, and dancers in our area and those in other associations in Florida.

Why should you be a member of the Association? Recruiting and expansion of our favorite activity take a lot of people to make an impact. Having an organization that ties all the dancers, clubs, and lessons together improve communications and provide an exchange of information. Your dues support our association, so we can (1) hire callers and cuers for our seven FREE membership dances, (2) reimburse clubs, callers, and cuers sponsoring new dancer classes for up to \$150 in advertising expenses, and (3) provide a voice from our area to the Florida Federation. We play a big part in the planning of the annual Florida state convention. Our national organization, United Square Dancers of America (USDA), has the bargaining power to negotiate a square dance insurance policy for all of us. This policy gives us secondary health insurance and liability insurance for the club. The USDA also provides a large number of informational pamphlets for our use, a discount prescription card for all of the dancers, and is currently assisting us with obtaining a 501(c)3 ranking, which will eventually flow down to the individual clubs.

Interesting Facts About Washington

Can You See Us Now?

During World War II, there was a secret B-17 bomber-making factory south of Seattle, Washington. To hid the factory from potential attack, Boeing camouflaged it by entirely covering it with a fake neighborhood created by a Hollywood set designer!

Potatoes and a Pia

America has goe to war with quite a few countries and even itself once over the last few hundred years. One of the countries we kept peace with over the year was Canada, thought that almost didn't happen.

In 1859 there was a confrontation between the British and the United States over country boundaries in the Pacific northwest. It was then that we almost went to war over a pig. 69th National Square Dance Convention® Camping

Camping for the 69th NSDC will be at the Spokane County Fair Campgrounds. It is approximately 5 miles from the Spokane Convention Center. There are 340 spaces for Convention campers. Spaces are given on a first come first serve basis. If you plan to camp near friends, you must

arrive together. To sign-up for camping, complete the applicable section of the Registration form (Long Form) indicating nights desired. Camping is \$45 per night, with a 4night minimum

The Spokane County Fair Campgrounds offers guests the following features:

- 110 sites with either 30 or 50-amp service
- 90 sites with 20-amp service
- Water hook-up available throughout the campground. (Campers are requested to bring a splitter for water hoo0up.)
- Sites to accommodate 4-+ units
- Onsite dump station
- Shower facilities available

Scheduled RV Park events Include:

- After party for Friday night. (Callers to be determined.)
- Breakfast potluck. (Date to be determined.)

Shuttle service will be available for \$50.00 per person. To sign-up for Shuttle service, complete the applicable section of the Registration form (Long Form). Please have your shuttle requests submitted by May 15, 2020!

Currently, plans are to have two shuttles running from June 17 to June 20. Shuttles will start at 7:00 am from the Fairgrounds. The last shuttle will depart the Convention Center at 11:30 pm. Shuttles will have 40 minute round-trips.

RV Park maps, directions, and information on area shopping and services will be included in future editions of the 60^{th} NSDC E-Magazine.

Planes, Trains & Automobiles (Transportation Options to Spokane)

Planes: There are 6 major airlines providing service to Spokane International Airport daily.

Trains: Trains arrive daily from the east and west coasts at the Spokane Terminal Center. This central station is a 10-minute walk from the Spokane Convention Center or catch a cab to your hotel.

Automobiles: Spokane is an easy scenic drive from several regional cities. Interstate 90 takes you over the Cascade Mountain Range to Seattle in four hours, through the Rock Mountains to Missoula, Montana in three hours, and just over the Idaho border to Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, in a quick 40 minutes.

Transportation Around Spokane (Spokane Transit Authority)

Don't stress the drive, let Spokane Transit (STA) do it for you. STA provides Fied Route bus service on 41 different routes with 147 buses, 28 of which are hybrid (diesel-electric) vehicles.

Parking Availability

There are a variety of surface parking lots and garages located n Downtown Spokane and adjacent to the Spokane Convention Center. The map of parking lots is available on the Downtown Spokane Partnership's website: downtownspokane.org/transportation.

If you want to determine the rate information for a specific parking location, click on the "P." This will provide the name and address of the parking location, hourly rate, and daily rate. Please note that there re NO in and out privileges at any of the parking garages or surface parking lots, except those for registered guests at a hotel as indicated below.

- 1. I wish that more dancers would take advantage of the invitation from CALLERLAB to attend its annual convention. Here is a chance for dancers to attend any committee meeting or interest session and witness everything that happens. The next convention will be April 5 8, 2020, in Reno, Nevada. - 2. I wish that teachers of Beginners Classes would emphasize fun vs. the learning of call names. So what if the class runs longer? It is likely to cause dancers to stay enthused and thus remain in the activity
- 3. I wish that club would only graduate from Beginners Class those who achieve at least an average standard of ability, instead of graduating everyone no matter how poorly they dance, thereby causing discouragement for others in the class and club members.
- 4. I wish callers would eliminate 95% of their use of Do-Sa-Do. This double reversal of body-flow call makes any dance less smooth the more it is used. Big-name traveling callers seem to use this a lot, especially in singing calls, thereby conveying the attitude that they don't care about smoothness that they just want people to drool over how beautiful their voice is. But this causes new callers to think they should use Do-Sa-Do all the time too.
- 5. I wish There was consistency at the National Convention. Things that are good one year an easily be bad the next year, and the dancers will not know until they are there, and then it is too late. Latest example: Bad sound in the large halls at 2019 National in

Atlanta, Georgia. The National Convention Executive committee says it has printed guidelines for everything, and this is true. But once a city has gotten the bid, it has free reign to do whatever it wants with little oversight on standards. I have been making this wish for consistency for over 30 years, so I have o hope that anything will change
