Positions with the West Coast Association Elected Positions (Elections in August)

- **PRESIDENT:**
 - (1) shall preside at all meetings of the Association, (2) shall appoint all committees and designate the Chairman thereof, (3) shall at his/her discretion, appoint the following or any other standing committees:
 - **MEMBERSHIP:** (1) shall endeavor to increase the number of clubs within the Association's jurisdiction (2) increase the members in the Association (2. It shall endeavor to promote closer fellowship between all the clubs by exchanging information of the different clubs' activities (5) shall maintain adequate records of individual memberships in the Association
 - **PUBLIC AWARENESS –** (1) shall make certain that all member clubs are advised of the happenings of the Association (2) and publicize the work and the coming events of the Association

- **VICE PRESIDENT**
 - shall preside in the absence of the President and shall assume full duties at that time.

- **SECRETARY**
 - (1) shall keep a complete record of all meetings of the Association, (2) shall prepare and distribute to all members of the Governing Council, copies of minutes of all meetings, (3) shall publicize in the West Coast Dancer magazine, all meetings of the Governing Council, (4) shall keep an up-to-date list of all member clubs (those sending Representatives to the Governing Council) with the names, addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses of the club officers and Representatives and, where possible; listing the dates and places of activities of the clubs.

- **TREASURER**
 - (1) shall collect all dues, (2) shall keep a record of all receipts and disbursements and make a report at each meeting when requested by the President, (3) deposit Association funds shall be deposited by the Treasurer in the name of the West Coast Square and arrange for records to be audited at the expiration of term
