

Book your accommodations now! Special square dance rates have been negotiated at two hotels and several campgrounds. If you wait too long, the special rate will not be available! If you find out a hotel or campground is booked up, please notify sqdncfan@gmail.com. Perhaps we will be able to negotiate more availability at the square dance rate. If there are any changes, you will be notified.

- 1. **Homewood Suites**: 265 Bill Francis Boulevard, Daytona Beach 386-258-2828 ask for the square dance rate of \$99 + tax for king suites, \$109 + tax for one (1) bedroom king suites, \$119 + tax for one (1) bedroom double queen suites. The is the host hotel and four miles from the Ocean Center. There will be after parties Friday and Saturday nights at this hotel.
