

MORE FACTS ABOUT GEORGIA The Little White House

Franklin Delano Roosevelt (FDR) built the Little White House in Warm

Springs, Georgia, in 1932, prior to being inaugurated as United States President in 1933. He frequently came to Warm Springs to swim in the buoyant 88° warm spring waters to help reduce the effects of polio that had struck him in 1921.

During FDR's presidency he developed many New Deal Programs (such as the Rural Electrification Administration) based upon his experiences in this small town.

FDR passed away at the Little White House in 1945 while posing for a portrait.

Irbyville – One of Atlanta's Most affluent Neighborhoods

The community formerly known as Irbyville, now arguably Atlanta's most affluent neighborhood and shopping mecca of the South, Buckhead, owes its unusual name to 19th Century local general store owner Henry Irby. Irby killed a large deer and prominently mounted the buck's head on the wall of his establishment, a popular outpost for locals and travelers. The name stuck.

Buckhead is home to many notable celebrity residents including Tyler Perry, Jane Fonda and Elton John.

Today we explore the heart of the New South, Atlanta – birthplace of Scarlett, Ashley, and that Yankee scoundrel, Rhett Butler. Scarlett never experienced today's Atlanta; but, be assured, she would have loved it. She would have been the first one on the bus! So, get ready for the stories of Scarlett's Atlanta.

Our tour route will explore Atlanta's famous Peachtree Street from the suburbs to the city. Indians cut the first trails; Settlers drove their livestock down those trails. Then came the railroads, the war and two armies — one staggering and the other victorious. That was 1864. As we follow that same Peachtree Street today, you will see the sights and sounds of the high-tech city of tomorrow. From Civil War sites to Atlanta's first Victorian subdivision to old favorites like the Fox Theater and the Capitol, we will tell you the stories of how this tiny little railroad terminal grew to be an international city.

Atlanta, like Scarlett, is always in a hurry, reaching for tomorrow, but we weren't always so big and beautiful. Lest you forget ow far we have come, we will take you to the Atlanta History Center for an unforgettable look at Scarlett's town during that long-ago Civil War Battle of Atlanta, July 22, 1864.

We will visit the birthplace of Scarlett O'Hara with a tour of the Margaret Mitchell House. Ms. Mitchell painted a picture of the old South in her book and movie, Gone with The Wind, which still brings people to Atlanta searching for Tara. This is the apartment where she lived with her husband, John, when she wrote of the book, garnering her the Pulitzer prize, and the movie, which received a record 10 Academy Awards. It all started right here on Peachtree Street in a tiny little apartment dubbed "The Dump" by a tiny little woman named Margaret Mitchell Upshaw Marsh. Atlanta always just caller her Peggy!

Our next stop is lunch at Mary Mac's Tea Room. For over 70 years Mary Mac's has been setting the standard for Southern cooking in Atlanta. Business people, celebrities, families and world

travelers all dine at Mary Mac's and feel right at home. In fact, in March of 2011, The Georgia House of Representatives created Resolution 477, in which Mary Mac's was officially declared to be Atlanta's Dining Room!

Next, we're off to Jonesboro to visit the road to Tara Museum and Stately Oaks Plantation, the type of upland plantation Margaret Mitchell had in mind for her book.
