From the Editor...

Please sending your dance and class schedules meeting dates and deadlines. This doesn't mean just the clubs; the Federation, Callers, and campers are included in this request. Early advertising makes for better results! Early scheduling means less chance of conflicts. As a reminder, I maintain a master

calendar of all the local dances, West Coast, Federation, FCA, and RDCF meetings, conventions and festivals that would affect your attendance. If you are planning a big dance or some special dance, you might want to check with me to see if there is a conflict. We all need to start promoting the activity, not just your dances or classes. If someone you talk to can't do a class you have scheduled because of the day of week, let them know about other classes in your area that are on different nights.

All of the seasonal clubs are closed now. Some will start re-opening in October, another group opens in December, and then the final group opens in January, and then in March the snowbirds start heading back north and the end of May will all be closed again. If you are a year-round resident but your club is seasonal, please consider visiting the year-round clubs. This will keep you dancing through the summer and will help those clubs that are open during that time.

Please consider attending the National Square Dance Convention in Atlanta (Marietta) June 26 - 29. It's practically in our background! Ribbon prices increases every so often so if you delay purchasing yours you will have to spend a little more money. Centennial Award

Introduction:

In the fall of 2013, we received an inquiry about what USDA does for square dancers that have reached the age of 100. Most of us did not know we had dancers of that age, so we did not have a program to recognize them.

A little research revealed some interesting facts about this age group. Currently it is the fastest growing population in the United States. The 2010 US Census reports over 53,000 people living in the United States are age 100 and above. With the current medical advances, improved diets, and changes in lifestyle this number is expected to reach a record high by mid-century. Not only are we living longer today than ever before, we are remaining more physically and mentally productive in our later years.

At the winter meeting of USDA in January 2014, a proposal was introduced and approved to begin a program of special recognition to those individuals that had reached the age of 100 and were still either dancing or still taking part in their Club activities.

Purpose

As the world's largest square dance association, the Executive Committee of USDA is proud to provide a "Centennial Awards" program for this group of dancers.

The qualified recipients will be given a nice framed "Certificate of Recognition and Appreciation" signed by the President of USDA and the Vice President of their Region. They will also receive a "United Square Dancers of America Centennial Award" lapel pin. This award will be presented to them by a member of the Executive Committee at a dance attended by the recipient when possible. Should the recipient be able to attend the USDA Board of Directors meeting the day prior to the National Convention, USDA will pay their Convention Registration. Finally, our USDA NEWS will honor them in a special "Feature Article" about them. When available we also include pictures of their receiving their awards from the USDA representative.

Qualifications:

We have tried to keep the qualifications for earning the Centennial Award simple. The most difficult part is reaching the age of 100. That is the number one criterion on the list of qualifications. Once you have met the age requirement you are well on your way.

Requirement number two is that you are still active in the square dance community. This does not require that you still dance, but you must still attend dances on a regular basis and be involved in the club in some way. This may be sitting at the front table and welcoming dancers as they come in.

Requirement number three is that you must have a minimum of five years membership in your club.

Once you have qualified for the Centennial Award, you must notify USDA by completing a nomination form.

You Have Never Thought About This

What job requires more decisions to be made in a shortest period of time than any other job in the world? Answer: Square Dance Caller.

When people hear this, they think it is a joke. But then they realize it is not a joke – it is truth.

A caller must make 8-10 decisions every 2-3 seconds. These include (1) knowing how long it will take the dancers to do it all, so as to know when to give the next call, (2) knowing what formation the named call will give; (3) knowing if tis call will flow smoothly after the preceding call; (4) Knowing what the next call should be from a variety of options; (5) knowing if that next call will flow smoothly from the preceding call; (6) deciding the correct timing for this particular call, based on whether the floor is weak, average, or strong; (7) knowing if the next call I "on the list" for the advertised program for the dance; (8) giving the calls on the beat with the music; (9) knowing who the partners and corners are in multiple squares; (10) knowing how to resolve to a Left Allemande and remembering which resolves have been used before so as to avoid repetition; (11) knowing where "Home" is if the caller wishes to use an "At Home" resolve.

Remember, all of the above is not happening two or three times a tip. This is happening every 2-3 seconds for every tip!

Having read the above, you are now trying to think of other jobs that require multiple decisions this fast. Let me help you.

What about a fighter pilot in a dogfight with another plane? Yes, we concede that a large number of decisions are made here in a short period of time. But a dogfight is over fairly quickly. It may last a minute or two, but that's it. A caller is doing this rapid-fire thinking tip after tip for the entire dance.

What about a surgeon in a complicated operation? The decisions are crucial, but they tend to be mapped out ahead of time, with a pause between each decision for implementation. In an emergency, there may be one minute of numerous decisions, but then there is I want to see what happens?" I have presented this idea to many people, and so far, no one has identified a job – requiring the number of decisions a caller has to make in such a short period of tie. If you can identify such a job, let me know.

Note: I am not saying that square dance calling is the most important job in the world. One the contrary, I can name hundreds of jobs that are more important for the advancement of humanity then that of square dance calling. All I am discussing here is the number of decisions in a short space of time.

A final thought. A number of years ago a psychologist was treating a caller for mental tress and drug addition (no, it was not me). He told the caller that the human brain is not designed to make the number of decisions in such a short period of time that a caller is requested to make.

Remember this the next time your caller misses the corner.
