As some of you may not be aware, Linda was undergoing treatment for cancer. Due to some of the side effects of the cancer medication, her oncologist took her off all her cancer meds until they could get her back on her feet again.

Her last cancer scan has shown significant growth and the oncologist is still reluctant to put her back on the cancer meds due to bleeding issues and possibility of blood clots.

She has been released from rehab to a Residential Assisted Living Facility. Her prognosis is not the greatest.
