CALLER OF THE MONTH Bill Marquis began his square dancing career in West Virginia way back when the dancers were dancing such traditional dances as Butterfly Twirl, Polka Eight and Lady 'Round the Lady. His first experience with dancing was in a set with seven girls. Right then, he knew square dancing was for him! One evening the caller was ill and he asked Bill to substitute for him. The caller assured Bill he could do it since the dances were all memorized. The caller was right, and Bill continued to call in West Virginia until he went into the service.

About 1956 Bill was again introduced to square dancing. This time it was the Western Style dancing we do today. He took lessons in the YMCA at Pittsburg, Penn. EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP - CAST A SHADOW

SET UP - From any couples circulate position, however the standard position seems to be arrived at from two parallel waves have the boys run which sets up a counter clock wise couples circulate with the boys on the inside and girls on the outside...

THE TEACH - Box 1-4 Do sa doe to a wave - boys run -

On the call CAST THE SHADOW (no need to designnate heads or sides)

The couple facing in will circulate half was; ending with the two boys locking left forearms - the couple facing out will have the girls roll back and catch the trailing girl with a right fore arm and turn 3/4 as her man (the man facing out) will follow or "shadow" his girl and will from the outside in move inbetween the two girls after they complete the 3/4 turn. The two center boys with left fore arms joined will turn left 1/4 or one step and step ahead and move up to the girl facing him to extend right hands to her and establish an ocean wave with boys in the center and girls on the ends.

CASTASHADOW will take about two or three walks to establish the dancing pattern but if you get the dancers to react to which couple is facing out and which is the facing in then they catch on pretty fast. NOTE teach from both sides as the dancers will learn their part facing out or in and will need to dance from from both spots. With the right

group this is a good workshop idea. Follow the teaching examples....

Dancing CAST A SHADOW

Box 1-4 Wave - boys run - Cast A Shadow - balance, Box 1-4 Wave - boys run - Cast A. Boys trade - boys run - bend the line Barge thru - star thru - crosstrail - left alle.

Box 1-4 Wave - boys run - Cast A Shadow. Boys run - bend the line Star thru-do sa doe to a wave-boys run Cast A Shadow-boys run-bend the line-slide thru-left alle.

Dance the above examples from both sides, heads pair off and sides pair off to waves then do the following...

Box 1-4 Wave-boys run-couples circulate. Cast A Shadow-boys run-bend the line Barge thru-pass thru-left alle.

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run-tag the. line left Cast A Shadow - boys run - bend the line Crosstrail-left alle.

Girls circulate - boys trade

Boys run-bend the line-star thru Dive thru-square thru3/4-left alle.

Shadow

CLUB LEVEL WORKSHOP - PEEL TO A WAVE - Red Porter

A simple addition to the Peel Off Family which is best done from the "Z" formation Box 1-4 Swing thru - girls fold - that set up for the "Z" and in Peel to a Wave the lead person peels off while the trailing dancer just steps ahead into the vacated spot and you end back in a wave. Not exciting but a logical part of the Peel Off Family. Easily taught and learned you can add some direction to the call by giving the person who peels off a clue like boys peel to a wave or girls but if you get one of each kind in the lead spot then they must ract to Peel To A Wave.

EXAMPLES Box 1-4 Swing thru-girls fold. (Boys) Peel To A Wave Swing thru-boys trade-boys run Wheel & deal-left alle.. Zero

Box 1-4 Swing thru-girls fold-Peel to a-Wave Girls tmade - scoot back - boys run Bend the line-slide thru-left alle. Zero
