REVIEW WORKSHOP FIGURE - TRADE THE WAVE

If you analyze the trend of the past few years toward what figures are catching on with the Mainstream you will find figures like Curlique, Walk & Dodge, Scoot Back etc. These figures are not the latest new ideas but figures that were second best to the Spin Chain Thrus or Runs that became Mainstream overnight. Notice they are all short action figures that are not combinations or "memory" courses. So with the majority of the newer experimental ideas being suited only for the advanced workshop dancers the Best Place To Look For Suitable Ideas For Use With Our Middle Ground Dancers Is From The Past. That's why we are reviewing Trade The Wave.

Trade The Wave is a partner trade type figure done from ocean waves. It is very handy to move dancers from the dixie style wave which is left handed back into a normal standard wave for easier usage. So with that in mind our teaching set up is from the Dixie Style wave...The Teach Ask the dancers to lean forward thru the wave and 'peek' at the dancer facing the same way in the wave. Now step thru the wave and trade places with the one you were 'peeking' at and reform the wave. The figure is easily taught and easily cued with the 'take a peek' - Trade The Wave. The figure has enough value to become Mainstream.
