# **Challenging Choreography**

Sometimes all that is needed to "spice up" some standard routines is the use of equivalents. The following are just a few ideas for some commonly used basics.

Swing Thru Pass the Ocean, Spin the Top

Right & Left Thru Pass the Ocean, Cast Off 3/4, Boys Run

Flutter Wheel Pass the Ocean, Girls Trade, Cast Off 3/4

JACK LASRY - Miami



### EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

PLUS I LEVEL:

DIAMOND WALK & DODGE....Skip Smith

A Diamond Walk & Dodge could be described as a cut the diamond but the points don't trade after they slide together....So in plain terms, from standard following diamonds of facing diamonds, the points will simply slide together (dodge) as the centers do a diamond circulate to become the ends of the forming two faced line or wave....From following diamonds you end in two faced lines and from facing diamonds you end in waves....The action is comfortable, logical but not really exciting, (what experimental is exciting anymore).....

BOX 1-4: SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..GIRLS HINGE..DIAMOND CIRCULATE.. DIAMOND WALK & DODGE..WHEEL & DEAL.. PASS TO THE CENTER..SQUARE THRU 3/4..LEFT ALLE..

BOX 1-4: WAVE..RECYCLE & VEER LEFT..GIRLS HINGE.. DIAMOND WALK & DODGE..BOYS CROSS RUN..GIRLS TRADE..WHEEL & DEAL.. PASS TO THE CENTER..SQUARE THRU 3/4..LEFT ALLE..

BOX 1-4: SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..GIRLS HINGE..DIAMOND CIRCULATE..
BOYS SWING THRU..DIAMOND WALK & DODGE..FERRIS WHEEL..
CENTERS SQUARE THRU 3/4..PASS THRU..U TURN BACK..GRAND RIGHT & LEFT..

SPLIT THE WAVE/SCOOT THE WAVE....Carl Wamsley

I really like the simple action of these two experimentals as they dance very nicely....The Split the Wave is a split circulate then the dancer who did the run portion of the split circ. will roll, the dancer circulating will 1/4 right and all step into a right handed wave (if a right handed split circ) Basic teach would be from a Box 1-4, touch 1/4....Split the wave....Part one split circ.... part two as the girls roll the boys 1/4 right....part three all step ahead to form the right hand wave...

The action would be the same in scoot the wave except the first action is a scoot back, the dancer doing the run will roll as the dancers doing the turn thru will 1/4 right and all step into the wave....



### MEMPHIS MEETING LEADS TO FORMATION OF NATIONAL SQUARE DANCERS ASSOCIATION

During the 29th National Square Dance Convention in Memphis, Tennessee, a meeting was held on Sat- able the promotion of the square urday, June 28, 1980, to discuss the feasibility of forming a National Square Dance Organization. More than 75 individuals representing 12 states from all regions of the country attended the meeting and openly discussed the desirability of joining the various State Associations, Councils, ted front from which to better Federations, etc., into a National present the entire square dance Square Dance Organization.

The meeting was the result of a survey conducted last year by the California Square Dance Council to determine how many of its sister organizations from around the country would be interested in joining with them in creating a National Square Dance Organization. This survey revealed that there was adequate interest to warrant further discussions. As a result, arrangements were made with Bob and Janett Kemper, Presidents of the Tennessee State Association of Square and Round Dance Clubs, Inc., to host a meeting during the 29th National Square Dance Convention.

Jim and Jan Maczko, Junior Past Presidents of the California Square Dance Council and Ed and Mary Barbee, Presidents of the Texas State Federation of Square and Round Dancers were selected to serve as Chairman and Secretary, respectively, for the meeting. Subsequently, their positions were established as permanent until the Seattle National Convention.

Discussion during the meeting centered around the fact that the lack of a truly national organization for square dancers has prevented the square dance movement from achieving some of its most coveted goals: designation of square dancing as the national folk dance of the United States: establishment of a uniformly recognized square dance week; etc.

Establishment of a national square dance organization could endance activity on a broader scale than is now possible within each individual state. Formation of such a national group would also provide for a line of communication between the various State organization leaders which does not now exist. It would create a united front from which to better removement on important issues which are constantly affecting the activity, and generally assist in the areas of education, promotion and furthering the enjoyment of square and round dancing.

At the meeting it was "Resolved that there is a need for a National Square Dance Organization to be called The National Square Dancers Association and that a committee of regional representatives be established to survey their regions to get a broader feeling of the other States and to encourage others to attend the next meeting", tentatively scheduled during the National Square Dance Convention in Seattle. It was generally agreed that square dancers would equally include round dancers, cloggers and contra enthusiasts together with all other factions which make up the square dance movement.

In addition, it was determined that it would be desirable for the Organizing Committee for the Formation of the National Square Dancers Association to schedule a Fall meeting at a central location with the intention of further detailing the purpose goals, and organizational structure for presentation to all State groups for their review and study prior to seeking their reaction at the Seattle meeting. This Organizing Committee consists of members from each of the 12 states represented at the Memphis meeting with each member being assigned a region within which to work. addition to Jim and Jan Maczko, 632 Camino de Clara, Solana Beach (continued on next page)
