



OF SQUARE DANCING ?

The reason for Square Dancing is obvious, it's FUN! If people didn't enjoy it they wouldn't do it. It's a wonderful form of recreation, where people can enjoy it, and share their own enthusiasm with others. But this does not answer the question: "What is the purpose of Square Dancing?" The main and most important purpose of Square Dancing is to have fun. Square Dancing is FUN. But like everything else in life, Square Dancing offers more than just fun. It offers a variety of things and experiences, i.e., the pleasure of social gatherings, companionship and friendship without all of the prejudice or the social aloofness of formal "stiff" society. People from all walks of life gather together, clasp hands in friendship, and are bound together by a bond as strong as America itself. Doctors, Lawyers, Politicians, Truck Drivers, Ditch Diggers, Bankers, White and Blue Collar Workers, and yes, even Religions all gather together to combine their efforts, and to share in the pleasures of Square Dancing. Square Dancing has encircled the World, people from all Nations join together with Americans to enjoy this excellent and wonderful form of recreation.



Square Dancing is infectious. Once you are exposed to it you become a part of it. You become an enthusiast, an addict. There is never a cold shoulder at a Square Dance. Everyone is your Friend. Square Dancers have traveled thousands of miles from home, and are welcomed as part of the regulars, being immediately taken into the homes of Square Dancers in other areas. This is why we say that "Square Dancing is friendship in motion, set to music."

But it doesn't stop there. There are still more benefits of Square Dancing - both psychological and physical. Square Dancing is a healthy release for our pent-up emotions. For a Square Dance to fulfill all of these needs a lot depends upon the Caller. In a sense the Caller is responsible for the attitudes of the dancers, and this is a very big responsibility.

The Caller's first responsibility is to call what the dancers enjoy doing. Many times this may present problems. Perhaps the Caller prefers one thing and the dancers prefer another. The dancers pay the bill and should be catered to. But never to the point of suppressing the Caller's individuality. There are many types and levels of Square Dancing. There is room for all. As water rises to its own level, so should dancers and Callers. Neither factor should completely rule the other. They too should work together in harmony for the joy and pleasure of both.

The successful Caller is the one who is able to estimate the experience of his dancers and call to them, according to their needs, and capabilities.

It takes hard work in addition to practice to make a good Square Dance Caller - but just being good isn't enough. We have all heard and used the expression: *"Square Dancing is for fun."* If this motto be true then it simply must be as much fun for the Caller as it is for the dancer. Relax, enjoy your calling, and you will find it a wonderful and rewarding achievement. Callers should tell the dancer from the beginning that *"Square Dancing is for fun,"* and he should not let them ever forget it. The Caller should study dancing, its origin, what it's all about so that he can explain these things to the dancers. Study about dancing as far back as you can go. You might explain to your dancers that Dancing has always been a form of self-expression. Originally, in the old days, dancing was a means of communication, a way of showing sensation, impression, sentiment, passion, sensibility, and a way to appease the Gods. It has been a form of communication of emotions for which there were no words. With the passage of time, our systems of communication have im-

proved somewhat, but the original basic instincts still dwell deep within our exterior surfaces. The desire for individual self-expression is indwelt and displayed in all of us. The rhythm and the music lifts us onto another plane of consciousness, where we forget the trials of the day, our worries, and the everyday pressures of modern living. This was dancing of the olden days, the meaning all throughout the years and is still the meaning of dancing today whether it is ballroom dancing or Square Dancing. We should be reminding our dancers today of these things. We should never forget to remind the dancers that: *"Square Dancing is for fun!"* and neither should the Caller ever forget this for even one moment. Be certain that the dancers are enjoying themselves, and make it a point to enjoy yourself and let the dancers see that you are enjoying it just as much as they are. Remember Square Dancing is the only folk dance - originated right here in the United States of America.

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami



THE PLUS PROGRAM

Last month I placed in the notes a suggested teaching order for the Plus I program. I would like to develop this program thru the coming issues with some teaching hints as well as some dance examples.

Prior to teaching any plus basics, I like to warm up the group by calling from the mainstream list and keep things pretty basic. Many dancers may be getting acquainted with that caller for the first time and we want to build confidence!!! The second tip of the night I teach the first plus call...ANYTHING & SPREAD...I start off by having the heads STAR THRU and explain that spread means that the centers will slide apart as the outsides will step ahead to end in between the centers forming a line of four. You can also say that you have no doubt danced this call directionally under the terms "outsides squeeze in to make a line". I remind them that the command & SPREAD is tacked on right after another call so as to allow the centers to spread apart without fully stopping the motion of their previous command.

HEADS STAR THRU & SPREAD...STAR THRU & SPREAD...
STAR THRU...CENTERS SQUARE THRU 3/4...LEFT ALLE...

ZERO LINE: PASS THRU...WHEEL & DEAL & SPREAD...STAR THRU & SPREAD...
STAR THRU...CENTERS SWING THRU...TURN THRU...LEFT ALLE...

HEADS STAR THRU...DOUBLE PASS THRU...CLOVERLEAF & SPREAD...
STAR THRU...ZOOM...SQUARE THRU 3/4...LEFT ALLE...

Developing some positioning with spreads:

HEADS PASS THRU...AROUND ONE TO A LINE...PASS THRU...
WHEEL & DEAL & SPREAD...PASS THRU...TAG THE LINE...
CLOVERLEAF & SPREAD...PASS THRU...TAG THE LINE LEFT...
FERRIS WHEEL & SPREAD...STAR THRU & SPREAD...
CENTERS SQUARE THRU FOUR...ENDS STAR THRU...
DO SA DO TO A WAVE...RECYCLE...LEFT ALLE...

For the third tip of the night I begin to call mainstream with an eye toward working thru the entire list and adding positioning combinations and where needed we teach or review. At this point in time I have a plan of which basics I will cover, usually no more than two or three, and as they smooth things out, I continue with using some anything & spread as part of my combination.

For the fourth tip I teach SINGLE CIRCLE TO A WAVE. I usually start at the zero box and teach by having the dancers take both hands and circle 1/2 way to their left, replacing each other, then step into the right hand wave. The key is to circle exactly 1/2!!!

ZERO BOX: SINGLE CIRCLE TO A WAVE...(you may wish to say single circle 1/2 to a wave) BOYS TRADE...BOYS RUN...WHEEL & DEAL...
RIGHT & LEFT THRU...ROLLAWAY 1/2 SASHAY...SINGLE CIRCLE TO A WAVE...
GIRLS RUN...BEND THE LINE...LEFT ALLE...

ZERO BOX: SINGLE CIRCLE TO A WAVE...BOYS RUN RIGHT...TAG THE LINE...
GIRLS U TURN BACK...SINGLE CIRCLE TO A WAVE...SCOOT BACK...
BOYS RUN...SLIDE THRU...LEFT ALLE...

For the fifth tip I teach EXTEND (the tag)...I prefer to use only the command EXTEND as often we use the command without any tag figure. I start by having the Heads Pass the Ocean and explain that extend means for the dancers in the wave to step straight ahead and establish a right hand wave with the outside couple. That rule will hold true as long as the center wave is right handed. If the center wave is left handed, TELL them to extend to a LEFT hand wave or else you will have problems. As you progress with Extend, set up parallel waves and call an extend; this will leave you with a wave in the center and the dancers extending out of the set must remain facing directly ahead. If you have set up a 3/4 tag formation and call extend, the center wave dancers will step ahead but no wave is formed as the outsiders have their backs to the center.



DANCERS MEET TO FORM NATIONAL GROUP

The Organizing Committee for the formation of a National Square Dancers Association, created in June, 1980, is pleased to announce the formation of the UNITED SQUARE DANCERS OF AMERICA. This new national organization was officially established June 26, 1981 during the 30th National Square Dance Convention in Seattle, Washington.

Nineteen states sent voting delegates to the meeting. In all, 135 dancer organization leaders were in attendance, indicating the strong interest in the need for a National Square Dancers Organization.

As the first official action taken by the voting delegates, three resolutions were adopted: The first created the new National Square Dancers Organization; the second lent support to the efforts to achieve recognition for Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance; and the third recognized the importance of the annual Tournament of Roses Parade float.

Future plans include the development of the following programs:

1. Strive for the unification of dancers.
2. Provide a National Square Dancers Insurance program for dancers, clubs and affiliate groups desiring coverage.
3. Establish lines of communication and cooperation with existing national organizations on behalf of the Square Dancer.
4. Be available to provide assistance to those desiring to organize for the betterment of the Square Dance activity when requested.
5. Develop a National program for the recognition of the Square Dance Leaders for their services to the

movement.

6. Serve to promote Square Dancing in all possible areas.

Generally speaking, the United Square Dancers of America is organized to provide the Square Dancer the opportunity to be recognized and heard.

The newly elected officers are:

President-Jim & Jan Maczko, California

Vice President Central Region- Jim & Peggy Seagraves, Alabama

Vice President Plains Region- Ed & Mary Barbee, Texas

Vice President Western Region- Claude & Polly Potter, Colorado

Secretary- Nate & Margaret Reynolds, Maryland

Treasurer- Joe Vaccari, Florida

Membership is open to "any organized non-profit Square Dance Group or other organized groups representing the Square Dancers within a State that will subscribe to the Purpose, Rules, By-Laws and Policies of the UNITED SQUARE DANCERS OF AMERICA...." States which do not have a state wide Square Dancers organization, or when a State organization elects not to join the national group, then area or regional organizations may join to represent the dancers of their state.

Charter Memberships will be granted to those organizations that qualify and join between June 26, 1981 and June 25, 1982.

Applications for affiliation with the UNITED SQUARE DANCERS OF AMERICA may be obtained from any member of the Executive Board.


