
One last item on new dancers. Have you ever visited a Contra Club? A new line dance club? No

Hope to see you in a Square. Have FUN! Bill Boyd




President's Message






Seaside Squares had their July Jamboree on the 20th which was well attended. There are having their 56th Anniversary



We start dancing again on September 10 for our Back to School Dance with John Swindle calling and Charlie Lovelace cueing.


