


President's Message

Many of us are back from Atlanta, Georgia, where we had a fantastic time at the National






OUR FADING FESTIVALS

Down the road. Around the bend Where does it go? Where will it end?

It is June! It is the month of our upcoming Texas Square & Round Dance Federation's annual square and round dance festival! At this time every year our club cancels the weekly Thursday evening dance and caravans to this gala square dance event. We support our festival!

I do look forward to the event to be held this year in Bryan-College Station, but my mind goes back to a point in time – June 6th to be exact, my 48th birthday. That is when I, and late taw Nora attended our very first square and round dance festival ever. It was in Dallas, Texas.

There were 5,911 registered square dancers in attendance. The Dallas convention center seemed packed, a Chevrolet Monte Carlo was given away as a raffle prize. A room with an untold number of vendors displayed an inventory of the most beautiful dresses, petticoats, men's embroidered shirts and scads of other square dance paraphernalia that I had never even imagined. It was 1981.

During that festival I had the privilege of dancing to some of the greatest Texas callers of all time. I won't try to mention them all – I couldn't. How many who called at that festival are still actively calling today? Here are a few I know of; Jon Jones, Charles Quisenberry, Tim Tyl, Robert Walker – and there is probably some I have missed.

It would be several years before I would become a picture in that prestigious program – mid 1990's – with year 2018 being my latest calling appearance at 'the festival'. It was in the beautiful Harvey Convention Center of Tyler Texas and by then there were about 450 registered dancers. There was no vehicle given for a raffle prize and the vendors fit comfortably into the expansive lobby. There were however, ten generous teen college scholarships awarded to deserving teenage square dancers.

For many years I have had the privilege of calling in the teen room and what a delightful experience it is. We, of the Texas State Federations of Square & Round Dancers have every reason to be proud of our teen scholarship funding program.

OK, we know the numerical attendance at our festivals is falling and I fear that square dancing could go the way of the twist, drive-in theaters, the shimmy, the Charleston, ice boxes and rumble seats. (Never heard of a rumble seat? My point exactly!)

The question! Can we adapt square dancing to attract the maturing millennial generation? I am not sure we can entice great numbers of them to adapt to the square dancing we do!


