#### Let's Start at the Very Beginning

So, you're coming to visit Spokane and attend the National Square Dance Convention in June of 2020, or at the very least thinking about it. You are certain to have a ball at the Convention

itself, but just in case you're interested in what else Spokane has to offer, you'll find at least a few tidbits about things to do, where you might want to eat, and trivia about the area here and in upcoming issues of the National Squares Online E-magazine.

Let's start at the very beginning - the wonders of Eastern Washington took millions (and in some cases billions) of years to form. Spokane sits on a combination of basaltic lava flows and silt, sand and gravel deposited by glaciers, and catastrophic flooding. Underneath (and sticking up here and there) are much older formations of the North American


continental plate, which is primarily granite. Steptoe Butte, 56 miles south of Spokane, is a prime example; take US 195.

Approximately 16 million years ago, fractures in the Earth's crust in

> the southeast corner of the state began to ooze basaltic

lava. These lava flows were huge, eventually filling the entire Columbia Basin. Spokane sits on the eastern edge of the Columbia basalt plateau, where the molten floods ran into the high ground of the

North American Continental plate. After the basalt eruptions ceased, erosion and periods of glaciation followed. Windblown silt began to accumulate on the basalt fields, covering everything with a frosting of rich soil. Then, about 15,000 years ago, a glacial ice dam, that had blocked the Clark Fork River in Western Montana for thousands of years, broke.





## ALL CALLERS ARE REMINDED

All important information is provided to you in the Bow & Swing. Separate letters will not usually be mailed to each caller for each event! So let us each always keep up to date with what's going on.

The contents, an estimated 500 cubic miles of water, came roaring down out of the mountains of North Idaho, spilling through Spokane and into the Columbia Basin. The floods created most of the familiar landforms that have come to define Eastern Washington – spectacular "dry" falls, huge, waterless coulees, perplexing basalt formations, giant ripple marks and unusual gravel bars.

If you want to get up close and personal to some of this:

- The Dishman Hills area (just south of Sprague Avenue between Park and Dishman-Mica roads) is a great place to hike and take in the wonders of geology. Older granitic rocks of the hills rise out of the basalt formations that cover the Spokane Valley. A trail loops through the wilderness area and contains many side routes that may turn a small hike into an all-day excursion.
- To the west, the Bowl and Pitcher in Riverside State Park features bizarre basalt formations cut by the flowing Spokane River.
- Spectacular columnar basalt formations (formed as the basalt flows cooled slowly and evenly) can be found in the road cuts west of Spokane along I-90, Sunset Boulevard, Geiger Boulevard and Garden Springs Road. These rocks are shipped around the world for decorative purposes, but you can see them right here.

So, you will sound like a local - before we go any further, it might be good to cover a few word pronunciations for those not well acquainted with the Spokane area.

- Spokane and neighboring Spokane Valley it's "Spo-CAN", not "Spo-CAIN". Spokane's official nickname is the "Lilac City", named after the flowers, that have flourished since their introduction to the area in the early 20th century.
- Coeur d'Alene just east of Spokane and across the border into Idaho is the city of "KORE-duh-LANE" and nearby Lake "KORE-duh-LANE". Coeur d'Alene is the name of an American Indian tribe that lived in the area. They got the name Coeur d'Alene, which means "heart of an awl," from French-Canadian fur traders.
- Pend Oreille both the County in the far northeast corner of Washington and the Lake in northern Idaho are pronounced "PAWN-duh-RAY". Pend Oreille is French for an ear-hanging or pendant. The lake is shaped much like a human ear when viewed from above or on a map.
- Palouse is "Pa-LOOSE"; Cheney is "CHEE-nee", and Coulee is "COO-lee".
- And even though some locals may say it that way, there really isn't an "R" in Washington.

A gathering place – Spokane Falls and its surroundings were a gathering place and focus for settlement for the area's indigenous people for thousands of years. So, let's all gather in Spokane in June 2020, and enjoy the National Square Dance Convention and all that Spokane has to offer.


