Visit several sites important to the Spokane Indian Tribe that lived in the Valley by the River for centuries. Learn

about the early fur traders and their relationship with the Spokane Tribe, much friendlier than what is depicted in the Oscar winning movie "The Revenant"!

The tour starts in town, Spokane, WA where poet Sherman Alexi composed a narrative of the legend the grandmothers told about the trickster, "Coyote", the ground of Overlook Park.

Walk the story which overlooks the Spokane Falls. Stop at Drumheller Springs Park and view the results of natural geological events that shaped this


