

Florida Callers Association



Callers and Cuers even though months away have started planning. Hotel and motel reservation already made.


It would be really nice to see all the Callers in Florida, along with their clubs in attendance, probably not feasible, but it would be nice.





# PRE-CONVENTION TOUR Glacier National Park June 15, 16 & 17

DAY 1 – Learn about the geology, Native Americans, and miners of the Silver Valley, as you travel across the North

Idaho Panhandle. Tour the oldest building in the State of Idaho, the Cataldo Mission, built by the Indians and early Missionaries in 1853 and see the world-class exhibit Sacred Encounters. Tour the Crystal Gold Mine and pan for gold and precious gem stones. Host-

ed lunch in historic Wallace. Follow the Clark Fork River and the banks of Flathead Lake. 
But even though we did not dance on the 4th we still had our annual "4th of July Picnic Friendship Dinner" only we held on the 11th. It was a great picnic too!
