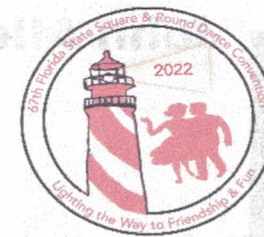
The Rollaways held their annual meeting Tuesday, April 20 and elected the following slate of officers:

LIGHTHOUSES #29 thru #32
Smith Shoal Light, Northwest Passage Lighthouse
Sanibel Island Lighthouse, Charlotte Harbor Lighthouse

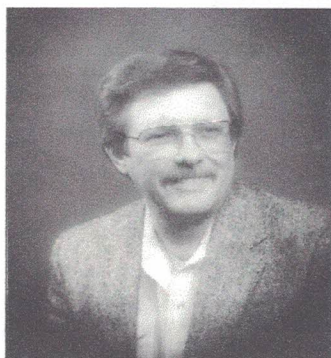
#29 Smith Shoal Light: Little is known about this Lighthouse except it was constructed in 1933 and was built to be unmanned. It is one of the screw-pile lighthouses which stands approximately only 54 feet high. Smith Shoal is northwest of Key West and a long way from anything. It is still in service today.

#30 Northwest Passage Lighthouse: This Lighthouse was delayed being built because of yellow fever among the workers and by unpredictable hard storms. This lighthouse finally was completed in 1855, but the lighthouse was plagued from the very beginning by fires and by a myriad of hurricanes and, of course, the usual wood rot. It was finally deactivated in 1921, 50 years before another big fire finished burning what was left from all the previous devastation. It no longer exists.

#31 Sanibel Island Lighthouse: This Lighthouse was written about earlier but here is a brief synopsis -- In 1833 and 1856 and again in 1877 a Lighthouse Board requested a Light be built on the island but Congress kept declining. It was not until after the Civil War that yet another petition was submitted to Congress stating that a lighthouse would cause a big increase in trade and that boaters and travelers would be able to visit the island more easily. Finally, in 1883 Congress appropriated \$50,000 for the project and the lighthouse was final started in February and lit in August of 1884. The lighthouse was built 112 feet above sea level with an external spiral staircase the lighthouse keeper had to climb to service the lamps. There were no provisions for a keeper to live inside the structure but a small home was built beside the lighthouse for his needs. There have been two recorded big hurricanes that struck the lighthouse but fortunately there was minimal damage either time. The first recorded one was in 1944 where it is said that several residents and the keeper clung to the outside spiral staircase after the keepers' home was destroyed -- all did survive. The second hurricane recorded was Charley in 2004 but predicted storm surges never materialized so nothing was lost.

#32 Charlotte Harbor Lighthouse: This Lighthouse was built and lit in 1890 and was a manned lighthouse until the end of World War 1 when the keeper and the assistant were dismissed. After a while, and since it was unoccupied for many, many years, it was torn down during World War 11.

Swindle (Leah Swindle), great nephews Grayson and Maxwell of Shawnee, Kansas, Wendy Hurt of Jacksonville, FL, Beth Accord, of Sylvester, GA, and Kelly Garcia of Cincinnati, OH. Many cousins; Monica Aiton of Gainesville, FL; Steve Aiton of South Carolina; Charles Grubbs of Valrico, FL. John graduated from Tullahoma High School, Tennessee in 1958 and attended Tennessee Technical University. John joined the United States Air Force and served four years. He was stationed at Turner AFB in Albany, GA where he met his wife Gail. John and Gail married in 1964 and moved back to Tennessee where he worked with The Arnold Engineering Center. In 1965 they moved back to Georgia where John worked for Lockheed. He left Lockheed and went back to school. Later accepting a position with Georgia Power.

After moving back to Georgia, John began his square dance calling career in 1968. As a team, they hosted, sponsored, and called at a vast number of very successful square dance events. Many of these events included some of the best known national square dance callers. They traveled far and wide across this great country bringing the joy of their favorite activity to thousands of dancers. John had called square dances for 52 years John retired from Georgia Power where he worked as a draftsman in the Electrical Engineering Dept. in Atlanta.

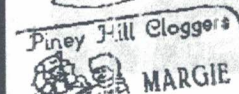
John also worked for CALLERLAB, The International Association of Square Callers when the Home Office was in Cocoa, Florida. John and Gail were an integral part of the CALLERLAB Home Office in Cocoa, FL for over 10 years. They were recognized numerous times by the CALLERLAB leadership, dancers, callers, and dance leaders for their untiring work, friendly attitude, true professionalism, and dedication to the activity. John served on the CALLERLAB Board of Governors and devoted many hours to help ensure the activity and organization provided the best possible dance experience to all dancers. In 2018 he received his CALLERLAB "Half-Century" award, recognizing 50 years as a caller. John was also an accomplished artist. He painted off and on since he was a teenager.

Has many paintings across the country and a few in Europe.

John and Gail are members of Faith Baptist Church in Rockledge. John was a member of CALLERLAB and served as President of the Florida Callers Association. 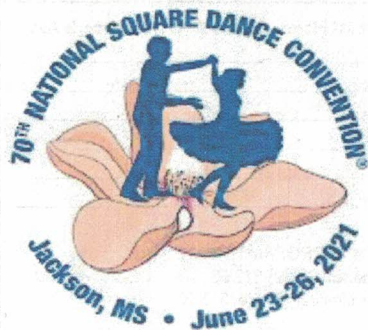

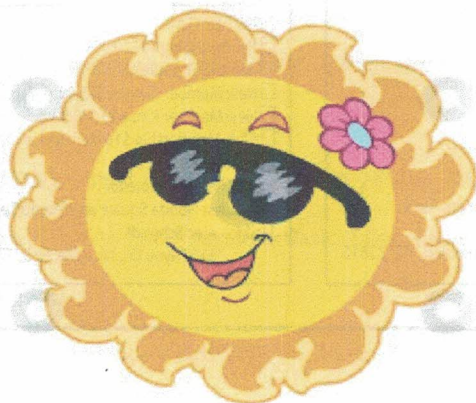
Is round dancing or line dancing more your speed? More than 20 hours of line dancing is planned, including beginner level classes. Round dance beginner classes will also be available.

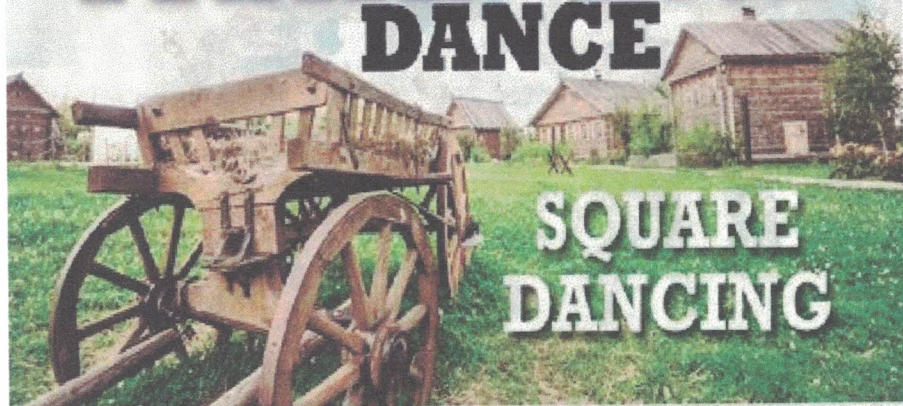

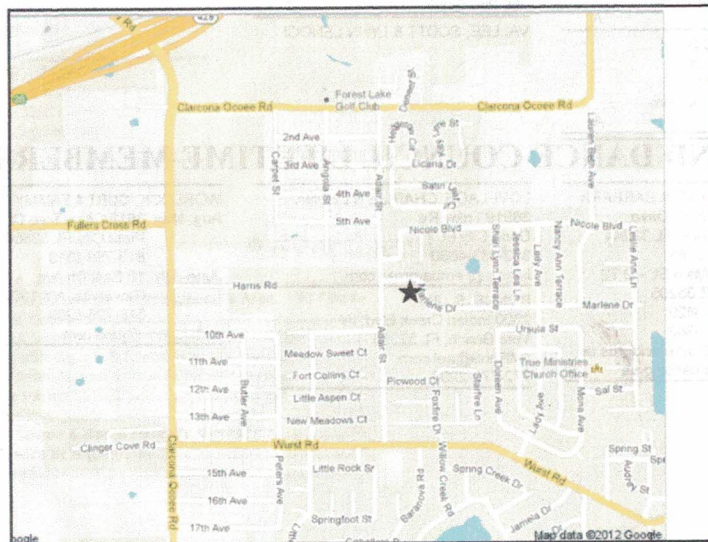
