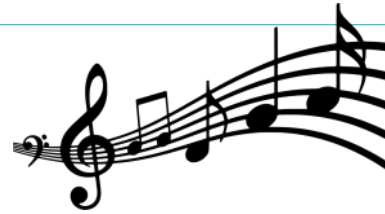

CONTRA DANCING



If you can square dance then you can contra dance!

Contra dance is a social folk dance in which lines of couples move through repeated patterns guided by a caller and live music. It is known for its welcoming atmosphere, easy-to-learn figures, partner interaction, and strong sense of community. In a typical contra dance, dancers form long lines, listen to a caller, learn the sequence during a short walk-through, and then dance the pattern to lively folk music. As the dance progresses, each couple moves along the line and dances with new neighbors, creating a flowing and social experience.

Great Ideas for Promoting Square Dancing

- **Every club needs an official outreach person**
- **Every club needs an up-to-date online presence**
- **Every member needs to get a t-shirt that is a billboard for square dancing, and wear it EVERYWHERE**

Clubs are steadily shrinking and we need to stop the decline of our sport. If each club has just one person who will concentrate on reaching out to new dancers, amazing things can happen!

1. Every club needs to have 1 or 2 people for outreach. Someone to photograph and video dances—and don't forget to make some videos in vertical. And someone to maintain contact outside the club, including social media and contact with community organizations. If you can get two people to work together, it not only lightens the load, but they can bounce ideas off each other—it's just more fun.
2. Clubs should have a Facebook, Instagram, and Tiktok account. In general, you'll reach people over 40 on Facebook, people from 20 to 35 on Instagram, and people in their teens and 20s on Tiktok. If you want to reach younger people, you have to go where they are. Youtube is also popular among all age groups. If you don't have a member who knows how to create social media accounts, someone has got to volunteer to learn. I'm here to help anyone who needs it.

3. A Facebook page or group has an admin, who can add posts. In a page, ONLY an admin can post. If you have a page, make sure you have at least 2 admins, because if your 1 admin dies, your page will be dead. Better still, have a group instead, where anyone can post, but even then, it's best to have at least 2 admins. If you can't find two admins, add me, but it's much better to have two from your club—the younger the better.

4. If at all possible, schedule an open house twice a year. You can't really get new people to come, without an event to come to. Leaflets and online posts aren't nearly as effective without a focus. It's also a good time for your current members to get family and friends to come. We're finding that just telling members to invite people they know has no effect because there's no target date. But telling them to bring people to an open house does get them to do it.

5. Every member of your club can do one small thing that can have a big impact: get a shirt with a LARGE message that says something like "I love to square dance!" And wear it everywhere. Out shopping, running errands...

6. Print up business cards for your club. I've used Vistaprint in the past. They'll print 100 cards for \$16. Each member gets a few cards to carry with them and give to anyone who seems interested. I will be glad to design your card if you don't have a techie member.

Setting up a tiktok for your club—First download the app.

Select a username and screen name. Both should be your club name or your square dance identity. Username has to be all one word, but you can run words together. For example, my username is squaredanceflorida because I'm working to revive modern square dance in Florida, particularly northeast Florida. I also made the name all one word but with caps—SquareDanceFlorida. You can use spaces in the name, but then it can be confusing for people searching for you—do they type it all together or with spaces?

Select a photo for your profile, A couple of people square dancing works well.

Type a bio. Make sure it's appealing. I used to "Modern Square dancing is so much fun! And there's probably a club near you!" If you're just promoting one club, you might say "Come have fun with the friendly dancers at the Seabreeze Square Dance Club in Jacksonville FL." Add a link to your Facebook page.

That's it! You're on Tiktok. Now find some accounts to follow. Searching for squaredance or square dance will find some kindred spirits. Try following clogging groups or line dancers. Some of them will follow you back. Yay!

Soon you'll add some videos. You can upload videos you take of your club or videos from other clubs. Vertical format is best, but any video will get you attention and likes. If you're interested in learning how to edit videos—to make them shorter or to add catchy text, for example—that's the next step. But it's not essential.

Cuer Corner

The song, “Teach Me To Dance” is sung by Taylor Hicks an American Idol Winner. He released this song the date of his Grand Ole Opry debut! It is a great Phase II + 2 (Hover & Interrupted Box) Waltz and I think most all Phase II Round Dancers will enjoy dancing it. I bought the music on iTunes and the full cue sheet is on Roundalab.com. The choreographers are Dan and Allison Drumheller from California.

Callerlab was formed in 1971 to standardize calls and provide adequate training for callers. Read about their history at the Callerlab website <https://callerlab.org/the-history-of-callerlab/>

Today, they foster square dance calling skill and providing leveling and order to calls to help retain dancers. Callerlab is an international organization for callers and leaders. CONTRALAB

Contralab is the international organization for contra dance leaders. It was established in 1986 to promote the contra dance activity. Contralab conducts workshops, seminars and classes for teaching contra and provides a forum to exchange ideas on teaching, choreography and other items of interest. Contra dance tends to use live music but can be done to recorded music. Contralab holds an annual meeting immediately prior to the National Square Dance Convention. IAGSDC (International Association of Gay Square Dance Clubs) is the international association of roughly 60 gay square dance clubs in the United States, Canada and Japan. All LGBTQ clubs are what most people would consider to be “singles” clubs. In many standard clubs, the defined unit of membership and dancing is a “couple”. In a LGBTQ club, the defined unit of membership and dancing is a “dancer”. Thus, while a square in standard clubs is considered to be formed of four couples, in LGBTQ clubs, a square is formed of eight dancers. As many dancers dance bidansual (adept at both beaux and belle or lead and follow positions), many clubs dance all position dancing or dancing by definition. Dancers of any sexual orientation are welcome at any IAGSDC member club. Each year they hold a convention in

a different city. In Florida, there are three cities with member clubs: Ft. Lauderdale, St. Petersburg and Pensacola. In fact, LGBTQ+ square dancing started right here in Florida with the South Florida Mustangs. Find a club in your area; you will find a lot of fun. Checkout their website <https://iagsdc.org/>

ICBDA (International Cued Ballroom Dance Association) is an independent, open organization of teachers and dancers dedicated to Choreographed Ballroom Dancing. There are currently over a thousand members of ICBDA worldwide. All ICBDA Officers, Board of Directors and Committees are unpaid volunteers, as are all Convention staff members. Originally, ICBDA was known as URDC (Universal Round Dance Council) and was created to satisfy a need for education of the intermediate to higher level dancers. The annual International ICBDA Convention offers dance clinics, figure clinics, and dance teaches. ICBDA also sponsors an Educational Seminar the day preceding the main event. National Executive Committee (NEC)

The NEC is tasked with overseeing the planning, guidelines and execution of the annual National Square Dance Convention® (NSDC). All members of this committee are past chairpersons of an NSDC. Each convention has an educational program, demonstrations and workshops as well as all dance phases, exhibitions, special events and shopping. These conventions started in 1952 attracting dance leaders and dancers from around the world.

They publish an E-Magazine August through May. This provides all the details of upcoming NSDCs. The NEC provides years of experience and assistance to those conventions so that they can successfully pull off the “World’s Greatest Square Dance Event”. Visit their website <https://nsdcnec.com/>

FANSDC (Florida Association of National Square Dance Campers) is part of the NSDCA (National Square Dance Campers Association). Florida campers dance the second weekend of every month with the Roadrunners club and the third weekend with the Square Wheels club. Non-campers are always welcome. An annual Camporee is held for all clubs to dance together. 2026 is their 50th year. ROUNDALAB A non-profit educational organization for round dance leaders world-wide, established in 1976 by round dance teachers to provide a framework for standardizing various aspects of the activity such as dance figures, cue terms, cue sheet format and teaching methodology. The mission of ROUNDALAB is to foster the art of round dancing by improving cueing skills and teacher excellence through education, standardization and cooperation with other dance organizations. USA West was formed to provide a national quality square dance convention in the western United States as the National Convention is not held in Western states as often as other areas.
