
Wednesday every month. We already have Susan Elaine Packer scheduled for the summer. Be sure to mark your calendars for this dance.

### FROM THE BARN HITCHEN

### **DIRT CAKE**

1 to 1 1/2 lbs. OREO cookies

2 small pkgs. Vanilla instant pudding

2 cups milk

8 oz. Carton COOL WHIP

1 large block cream cheese

1 cup powered sugar

1 & 1/2 stick margarine



Crush OREO cookies to look like dirt.

Set aside.

Mix vanilla pudding with milk and blend in the cool whip. Set aside.

In a separate bowl, blend margarine, cream cheese and powdered sugar until creamy. Combine both creamy mixtures.

In an 8" diameter plastic flower pot layer 1/3 OREO'S 1/2 creamy mixture, 1/3 OREO'S, 1/2 creamy mixture and top with remaining 1/3 OREO'S.

Place silk flowers in the center and serve with garden shovel.
