## FLORIDA FEDERATION OF SQUARE DANCERS Orlando, Fl. Feb. 22, 1970

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Sogolow at 12:15.

Officers of the Florida Callers Association, Neal Blanchard, President; Chuck Durant, Vice President; Roger Chapman, Secretary and Charles Lovelace, President of the Round Dance Council were introduced.

The roll call was made with 17 delegates present. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved after correction of dates of the State Convention from June 13 & 14 to June 11, 12 & 13.

The visitors were welcomed and informed they could join the discussions but could not vote on any motion brought before the Board of Delegates.

Lu Winters, General Chairman of the 1970 Convention was introduced and given the floor for his report. He addressed the meeting on the availability and distribution of flyers, brochures and auto stickers. He then introduced his committee chairmen and each gave a brief report. Ray Freshwater and Nick and Mary Nichols on registration; Mary McDonald and Plantation Squares, facilities; Syd King, treasurer and Ray and Laura Bookmiller, Round Dance Coordinators.

Mary McDonald reported the teen-agers of the Orlando area were interested on hosting all teen-agers at a party and requested a caller be made available for a two hour period. Neal Blanchard assured her this could be done.

Lu Winters authorized the Florida Callers Association to provide sound and equipment for the convention.

Charles Lovelace, President of the Round Dance Council asked for clarification of the split of Convention profits. After much discussion a motion was made by Paul Lane seconded by Len Levitt to request the Executive Boards of the Florida Callers Association, the Round Dance Council and the Florida Federation of Square Dancers to meet and try to arrive at a solution to this problem.

The next regular meeting will be held at the Robert Myers in Orlando on June 14, 1970.

Motion to adjourn was made by Walter Stoltz seconded by Paul Lane. Meeting adjourned at 1:30pm.
