Convention Reports:

1973: Ron confirmed the changed dates to Memorial Day Week End of May 25 Trails End Dance-26th & 27th at Curtis Hixon Hall, Tampa. Also his publicity will be handled by Jack Pierson.

1974: Pee Wee said Orlando was promoting their slogan, "More in 74." Facilities were confirmed. Dates Memorial Day weekend, May 23, 24 & 25.

Southeast: Charlie Selle, reported Southeast annual membership dance of October 10th shows 350 members which included 83 new members. They are shooting for over 600 members.

West Coast: Ron Van Valkenburg, reported there would be a renewal dance October 31st, Tampa and November 10th at Fort Myers.

Central: Chuck Mayo, reported their renewal dance to be October 31st and they are pushing the support of Bow and Swing 100%.

North East: Jim Whitman, reported their Fall Round Up with Marshall Flippo and the Smiths on the Rounds.

National: Harry Moore, reported that the National will be in Des Moines. He asked that the area magazines to be sent to the "Show Case of Ideas." 2. They would like a list of all organization officers. 3. Try to attend question and answer program on Saturday. 4. There is adequate facilities for campers. Fair grounds will probably erect tent for campers to dance. 5. There will be a youth program. 6. The people of Des Moines are very hospitable and friendly.


Chairman Veters introduced the new delegates.
