The Mayor of Orlando had declared Square Dance Week-He had received Governors Proclamation for the Federation declaring Square Dance Week.

All clubs are pushing Square Dance week and were going to participate in sche-

duled exibitions.

The Association had bought promotion materials for all clubs to use as class publicity. Such as posters and pamphlets. Behind the Bow and Swing 100%. The memberships are growing immensly.
