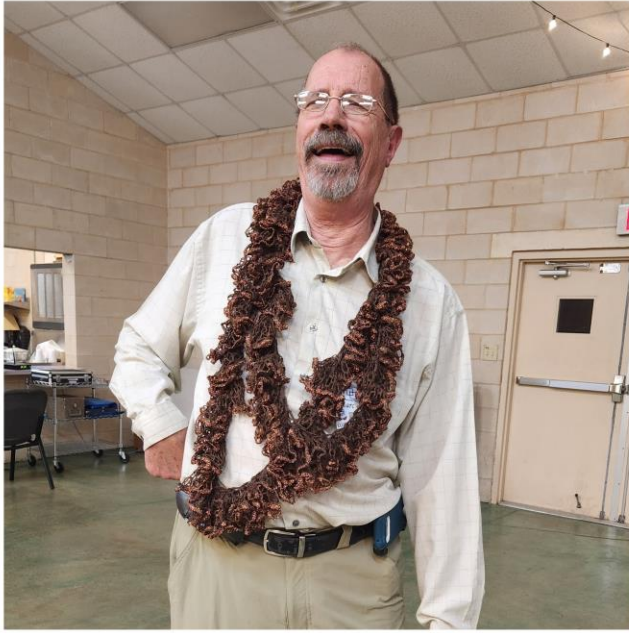

Spin chain thru is a call most of us are afraid to use. Why: Because we don't call it often enough for the dancers to be comfortable making the call. If they are plus dancers, they are thinking gears, so we have to be careful. I don't use enough star figures. Gary Murphy used to remind me of that. How many box the gnat's have you called lately? Think of the calls you don't use and add them in for variety. If you want some real fun, start calling some left-handed stuff. Just don't overuse it. The dancers must win. I hope to see all callers at the April 25th dance. We have not had a Gateway or RCA meeting since before Covid and I have missed seeing some of y'all. Now wash your hands, stay healthy and dance when you can and I shall return to my other article on the use of calls. Square 'em up.

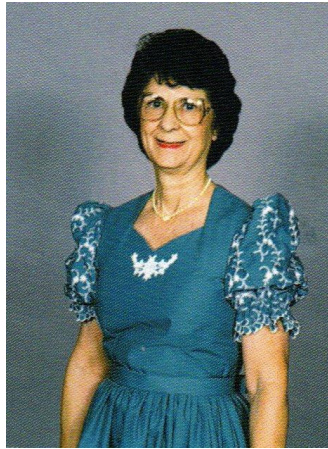

She is also survived by a grandson. Donna married 2nd Joseph James “Joe” Smith (1929-1995) who enjoyed square and round dancing. Donna was a superb seamstress, especially sewing drapes and square dance outfits. She enjoyed gardening, playing cards and volunteering to serve her community. She was well known for her homemade coconut cake and her carrot cake. Joe and Donna were active telephone pioneer partners and were members of Allemandarins, Challengers, Happy 2 Be, Quarter Mores, Sunshine Sweethearts, Teddy Bear Squares, and Touch of Class. After Joe’s passing, she was a member of Rollaways. Donna served NEFSDA, then NEFSARDA as an officer multiple time. She also served on two Florida State Conventions Committees. You could find her at the greeting table of many 5th Saturday dances. She contracted a bad case of COVID that impaired her ability to walk and talk. We who knew her are missing her as a dancer and as a gentle lady.

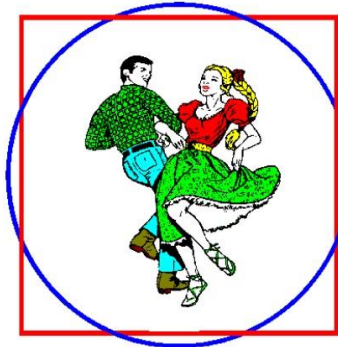
