Additionally, we demonstrated the goodwill of square dancers by helping fill the pantry at the Arlington Senior Center.





It also brought a couple of questions to me from other areas in the state and I decided to add them in this month.

Who is the callers biggest advocate and probably the most critical? Who is that person that is there for your caller or cuer all the time? I left home a couple weeks back headed to a dance and about halfway there realized I had not put my calling equipment in the car. Luckily Ms. Nut was home and willing to meet me and bring the equipment. That made it possible for the dance to happen and on time. My thanks go to my best supporter and critic. Calling is truly a team sport and I appreciate all that Mary does for me, the clubs I call for and for our activity.

I have been asked a few times over the years and again recently: Should clubs charge callers to dance at a club dance? I think the answer is way too complex. I expect to pay at any dance that I go to if I am there to dance. I am always grateful if a club doesn't charge but that is not expected. If a caller is a club member of their dance club, they should pay. The enjoyment should be worth the cost. Going back a few years ago, Robert Padgett was a member of the Moose Promenaders. If Robert was there to dance, he paid the admission charge. When he brought the Clay Allemanders to visit, there was no charge. My long answer is clubs do what you need to do, and callers always expect to be charged. And I still miss Robert.

At a dance a few weeks ago I heard a caller use "Dixie style to a wave", followed by" left swing thru". The motion for the dancer in the middle is a little over 360-degree turn. The flow would be so much smoother if the caller had used a "centers trade" before the" left swing thru". Next time maybe a little on Bobby Keefe's pet peeves: centers zoom and the call combination of star thru, veer left. I received word over the weekend that Bow and Swing is shutting down. Susan Elaine has worked hard on the magazine, but it is just no longer viable due to postage costs, production costs and reduced subscribers. It makes the Grapevine the best source of information on dancing in Northeast Florida. I will miss Bow and Swing.

Stay safe, enjoy dancing, look for new dancers and visit the clubs whenever you can. We will be watching for you in a square.


