

Stephen Frederick Fritz Bigelow went to be with the Lord on January 28, 2026. Stephen was born on July 28, 1958. Stephen served in the US Navy in 1976-77. Stephen was active in square dancing and his local Episcopal congregation. Stephen started **square dancing** in 1981 and met his soulmate Marie Johnson at a national square dance convention shortly after. They settled in Marie's hometown of Jacksonville, Florida and worshiped at St Catherine Episcopal Church, the church where Marie grew up. Stephen and Marie were very active in the local **square dance** community and served in offices in many of the local clubs as well as regional and state square dance organizations. Stephen also took on the responsibility of continuing the online publication of two local and state square dancing publications, *The Grapevine* and *The Bow and Swing*. Stephen was preceded in death by his wife Marie Bigelow. His father, sister and two brothers survive Stephen. There will be a memorial Service for Stephen Bigelow on Saturday, February 28, 11:00am at St Catherine Episcopal Church, 4758 Shelby Ave., Jacksonville, Fl., 32205. A reception will follow in the Parrish Hall.




