

But before we get that far away, we need to think of all the fun dances coming up in our area. October sees the Florida Camporee in Eustis, the FL Callers Assoc. dance and clinic in the Villages, our Fall Festival with Dave Vieira and then the Florida State Square and Round Dance convention in Deltona in January. There are plenty more and most have fliers in this issue of the Grapevine.

I touched last month on the issue of recruiting dancers. I believe there is no perfect way to find dancers but also believe that asking one on one is probably still the most effective. Any person in advertising can tell you that only about 10% works. So we could do away with the other 90%. If we only knew which 10% works. Try everything to spread the word. Some callers and clubs do a great job on Facebook. Give it a try and at least your friends will know why you are not home.

We had such a great time at the Spin The Big Top Fundraiser in Port Orange in May, that chairs Dawn and Charles have added a second one in November in Wildwood. It would be great to see a good turnout from the NE area as we work to support the state convention. November 9, 2024, 4:00 - 8:00 pm Wildwood Community Center.

Most of us callers only use Wheel Around from a promenade position. Callers, if you work to add wheel around to your choreography pattern you expand your and your dancer's capability. It is a fun call to use with two boys or two girls together, a place you cannot use right and left thru. Play with it some and see if it fits.

I hear that confession is good for the soul. So I confess that I do not get to dance enough. If we are not dancing, callers, we miss out on procuring some great choreography from others, as well as checking out body flow. Plus, I find out that when I dance it reminds me of what a great activity, we are part of.

I received news this week I never like to get. Caller Ted Hughes from the St. Pete area passed away following a long surgery. Ted never had big success as a caller but was one of the nicest guys you could meet. He loved the square and round dance community and will be missed.

Callers, it is time to plan to go to the FCA Fall Clinic. This year the clinic is in the Villages again and Kip Garvey is the clinician. The dates are October 17 – 20. There is no cost for the clinic for FCA members. If you are not an FCA member the clinic costs \$50. (Or just join the FCA.) 


