# <u>Grand Squares – Gainesville, FL –</u> Caller Lon Ligon and Caller in Training, Frank Plunkett



Further, the dance schedule for July will be as "hot" as the weather.





## Notes from Mobile – National Convention

# 2023 National Square and Round Dance Convention... A Real BLAST!!! By Bill and Paula Dion

Last week, we attended our second National Square Dance Convention with Debbie and Wayne Miller. It was the 72<sup>nd</sup> National Square Dance Convention held in Mobile, Alabama.

(As a side note, we discovered Paula was actually participating in her third National Convention as she attended the 16<sup>th</sup> National Square Dance Convention held in Philadelphia back in 1967! She was 12 years old when her mom and dad, who were avid Square Dancers, took her to the Convention. Stephen Bigelow asked me to write to you all on our experiences at the 72<sup>nd</sup>. So... here is a short article on the fun packed four days we enjoyed.

Not enough praise can be given to the National Convention Committee, those who hosted us all, as well as the City of Mobile for a great Convention and total friendliness that was present throughout the event.

Debbie, Wayne, Paula and I chipped in on a "ARB" comfortable cozy little 2-bedroom apartment only minutes from the beautiful Convention Center located right next to Mobile Bay harbor. It was perfect and allowed us easy exploration of the town.

The first night of the Convention, Wednesday evening, started off with the opening Ceremony, a wonderful dinner with the very best entertainment from the "Excelsior Band". The band played lots of bluegrass favorites plus other songs filled with fun jokes and skits. We were thoroughly entertained for a good part of the early evening.

Next was the Main Hall, where callers rapid fired their songs with the wonderful background band, "The Ghost Riders". We all danced steadily with lots of energy that night from 7- 10. We got to meet so many nice people from all over the country. We were lucky that many of the couples joining our squares were full of spirit and fun loving. It was a great starting night!

Next day, Debbie and Wayne took in the exciting Hexagon dance session while we took off on a tour of the "AirBus" Plant Facility and adjacent "Flight Works" Pavilion. This was a fantastic tour. In the Airbus main assembly building, Paula and I got to see the actual operations of airliner assembly from the beginning parts to a fully assembled passenger aircraft. Next, we visited the "Flight Works"

Pavilion. There was much to see and experience! There were many hands-on displays and aircraft assembly tools used in construction methods for aircraft and much more. There also was a wonderful virtual reality exhibit. Paula and I, for the first time, experienced virtual reality and took a walk on planet Mars and worked on and operated the "Rover Explorer"! In addition, I also climbed into a full-scale flight simulator. Though I am not a pilot by any sense of the word, I took some coaching and was able to safely land an Airbus jet passenger liner and taxi to the airport terminal.

As our exciting days continued, we found much to do and dance. We took in a fun time where the caller taught us several of the old-timey square dance calls. One being the "rattlesnake"! We also had fun participating as part of 21 squares doing social square dancing. We did Mainstream and Plus and visited the many vendors set up in one of the grand size halls.

We also found great cuisine in Mobile.... From traditional muffaletta sandwiches, oysters, shrimp, to great BBQ. A real pleasant surprise was "3 Georges" located on Dauphin Street, a combination ice-cream, candy and sandwich shop with an old fashion soda fountain. There was also a wonderful grocery store where we picked up breakfast items and also had the very best BBQ chicken and ribs and sausage, eating in a large dining area, right in the store!

On our last day, Saturday, we took in the Mardi Gras Museum which was spectacular! I never knew the origin of the Mardi Gras and what was all involved with both the royal societies. There is so much.... The Tradition, Administration, fancy coronations, float construction, and decorating and dress attire used in the Mardi Gras Celebrations and Parades.




