Seabreeze Singles Square Dance Club – a History

They said it couldn't be done! That is what Matt Wimpee, a local caller, was told when he decided to form a square dance club for the single dancers in northeast Florida. (At that time a single without a partner was not welcome in other clubs.) Matt found a place to dance, ordered badges and handled the organization and calling. Wanda Deason served as the first president in 1976. The first dances were held in a church on Atlantic Boulevard. From there they went to the Hogan-Spring Glen Elementary School. Classes were also held in a room under the swimming pool on Hendricks Avenue (aka the dungeon). How many of you remember this?) But everyone had fun and the club thrived. Incidentally, caller Mike Akers was a charter member.

After Matt had to guit calling in 1980, Ernie Millan became the club caller. In 1986 Bob Belanger took over until his job trandferred him to Alaska in 1988. Eddie Millan returned as caller until July 1993, his 32nd years as a caller. Jim Cosman took over as caller. Mike Akers started calling for us when Jim Cosman retired

Since 1976 the club has been forced to move several times. The last move was necessitated when the beautiful and historic Friday Musicale building burned to the ground in 1995 with all of our club's belongings in it. We missed just one week of dancing, moved to out present location, borrowed supplies from another club, and quickly got back on our feet.

In 1989 we began hosting an annual Valentine charity ball for the benefit of the Heart Fund. In 1994 [until 2018] we changed the beneficiary of the dance's proceeds to the City Rescue Mission. These people provide a great service to our homeless community and are always very appreciative of our efforts. We are proud of the many thousands of dollars our members, with help from the square dance community, have earned for charity.

We hold a monthly meeting (also ended in 2018) that is hosted at the home of one of our club members. There is a covered dish dinner (always delicious as we have some great cooks!) followed by a business meeting. Other outside activities are often planned for those who wish to participate.

Seabreeze Singles sponsores a mainstream class. Our members actively support local, state and national square dance activities. There are four singles clubs in Florida (Orlando Singles, Spares 'n Pairs in St. Petersburg, Swingin' Singles in Fort Back to Page 1

Lauderdale and us). Our members hold offices in NEFSARDA [North East Florida Square and Round Dancers Association] and FASSRD [Florida Association of Single Square and Round Dancers]. Even though the number of square dancers in the United States has deceased, the number of single square dancers has increased.

We welcome singles, married couples and married with non-dancing partners in our classes and club. We still keep active the spirit in which the club was formed: To promote and encourage square dancing and round dancing, and provide a place where single dancers may enjoy square dancing together in a spirit of friendliness and cooperation.


