



Florida Federation Working Weekend

We had a Federation Working Weekend this past weekend while we were in Maitland for the Shamrock Swing.

As part of the Working Weekend, we have breakout sessions and below are some highlights from some of the report outs:

- Show Case of Ideas This committee is chaired by the Federation Parliamentarians and one of their responsibilities is Florida's display for the National Convention in June. The 2008 display will be very similar to previous displays but will incorporate this year's State Convention Theme Celebrate Dancing". Each association will have a display board. The entire will display will be at the State Convention in May; be sure to stop by and take a look at it.
- Historian you may not be aware that there is a committee that has been collecting copies of association newsletters, copies of the *Bow & Swing*, past convention outfits, taking pictures, collecting past convention program booklets, etc. for the many years the Federation has been in existence and the collection has become so large that we have had to rent a storage unit to keep it all. This Committee was charged with coming up with some ideas on how to save all this historical material for prosperity. The recommendation was that all the written material be scanned and saved on CD, and all of the items will be photographed and also added to the CDs. The CDs will be shown at each of the state conventions. The items in storage will be returned to their original owners when this project is completed. This will be a huge project and many thanks to Donna Hendricks and Bruce Morgan for volunteering to take it on.
- Preservation, Education, Publicity this committee discusses the same things every year; how do we keep square dancing alive; how do we recruit new dancers and/or younger dancers. It was agreed that the top three ways are: 1) the internet can't be beat websites, emails, electronic newsletters i.e. the DANCERgram; 2.) business cards (personal and business) that mention square dancing, "You have been patronized" cards or USDA Prescription Discount Cards. Have you thought about giving out the USDA Prescription Discount Cards when you eat out or go to the bowling alley, etc.. People will remember that a square dancer helped them out and this may bring them to square dancing. This prescription discount card can be used by anyone; you do not have to be a square dancer to benefit from it. A story was relayed about a worker at a bowling alley who needed a heart medication that was going to cost \$400. When she presented the prescription discount card, they took \$100 off the bill. She will always remember that a square dancer gave her that card. A suggestion was also made that we need to get our square dance links on other non-dancing sites i.e. health, entertainment, etc.

It was decided that effective in 2009, the annual Working Weekend will be held separately from dance weekends and will be held on February 28th. The location will be determined by the Federation President and will be announced at a later date. There will be a Saturday night dance held during the Working Weekend, and the proceeds from the dance will be donated to the upcoming State Convention for that year.

The next Federation meeting will be during the Florida State Convention on Sunday, May 25th at the Lakeland Center in the Lake Morton Room at 9:00 a.m. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend.
