Russ Williams and I met with the sarcoma surgeon Monday, Nov. 9th. After much discussion about the 2 choices he had offered before, Dr. Letson advised that there might be another option called "Limb Infusion with Chemo". This procedure would be to fill the knee with chemo, which would kill the diseased cells and not do any surgery/removal of the knee or part of the leg.

The small tumor on his upper thigh could be removed at the same time and Russ would then be on his way to recovery with minimal healing time from the 2 procedures. Given Russ' history of cancer from the surgery 5 years ago, his age, and his earnest desire to be as mobile as possible, Dr. Letson thought this might be a good plan. (This is my understanding of the procedures as explained by Dr. Letson.)

Russ is scheduled to meet with a Coetaneous Oncology doctor this Monday, Nov. 16th to get more details on the "Limb Infusion" procedure and if it is do-able.

This seems like the best news we have heard and I am sure that prayer has the most to do with it. I don't know if there will be one infusion of the chemo or more, but we will have more info after meeting with the new doctor.

God is so good and we are grateful for His love and the love and prayers of our many friends and family.

Please keep praying that the doctors will make the right decision. More reports later.
