#### Joseph John Vaccari (1923 - 2011)

Joseph J. Vaccari, 87, of Fort Walton Beach, Fla., passed away Saturday, April 16, 2011. He was born in Memphis and was a 46-year resident of Fort Walton Beach. Joe was a 39-year civil service employee, working mainly at Brookley Navy Base in Mobile, Ala., and at Eglin Air Force Base in Fort Walton Beach.

He was a World War II veteran who recently attended an "Honor Flight" to Washington, D.C. Joe was an active square dancer on the local, area, state and national level, and past president of the United Square Dancers of America (USDA), and the Florida Federation of Square Dancers. He was also a member of Sons of Italy and St. Mary Catholic Church in Fort Walton Beach.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Doris Vaccari; brother, Louis Vaccari; and sister, Rose Bonicelli. Joe is survived by his wife, Joy; children, David (Dianne) Vaccari, Gregory Richardson and Barbara (Rich) Richardson Sigler; grandchildren, Dana (Cheryl) Vaccari, Dory (Eric) Ferlo, Darla Vaccari, Kurtis, Kyra and Keely Sigler; and great-grandchildren, Aviahnna and Addison; cousins, Marie Wakefield of Memphis, and Pauline Brown of Jackson, Tenn. He is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

Burial, with military honors, was held on Friday, April 22, at Barrancas National Cemetery, Pensacola, Fla.

Message from Paul Miller: Joe Vaccari enjoyed Square Dancing and believed that it was the most fun recreational activity. His belief was proven by his actions; Joe was instrumental in starting a Northwest monthly Newsletter on February 1975 to let the clubs know where the dances were being held in the Northwest area; he was Editor of this Newsletter (to become the Panhandle Press) from 1975 – March 1977. He served as the Northwest Square & Round Dance Association President from 1974-1976. In December 1975 he assisted with forming the Northwest Florida Square & Round Dance Association, Inc. and immediately worked to get Northwest included in the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, making Northwest the fifth region of Florida.

He served as President of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers from 1978-1979.

Not slowing down he traveled to Memphis, TN in June 1980, to be part of the "Organizing Committee for the formation of a National Square Dance Association" to become the United Square Dancers of America, Inc.

His commitment to the USDA has been a long road from 1981- to the time of his passing. Serving as Treasurer, President, Showcase of Ideas, Museum, Square Dance Commemorative Postage Stamp Campaign, USDA Credit Card, USDA Badge and USA Traveler Committee Chairman.

Joe was inducted in the Florida Federation of Square Dancers "Hall of Fame" in 1989.

The Square Dance Community throughout Florida will miss him. Joy, our prayers and thoughts are with you and your family at this time, we share your loss.

## Cory-Ography In the Classroom

When approaching the schools about teaching a square dance program, keep in mind that you will be instructing more than just dancing. When you speak to the principal or contact person, make sure you sell yourself and square dancing by explaining the social and physical benefits from dancing. A great way to get into the schools is selling it as a gym class and a music appreciation class. Also, what an interesting history lesson you could have before even dancing. Or what about the students who enjoy math? There are definitely mathematics involved with square dancing.


