

REGISTRATION & HOUSING INFORMATION

It is important to fill out and send in the Long Registration form before the Convention. The NEC requires every dancer to fill it out before picking up their Badge and packet. This will save you time in line.

The registration fee is currently adults, \$50.00; youth age 5-17 by 6/27/2012, \$25.00, under 5 years Free

There are a limited number of Program Books printed. The price is currently \$10 per book. Daily schedules are included with the Program Book. In the Daily Booklets, the dancer can easily find information on the Callers scheduled in the numerous halls, the Round Dance Showcase of Rounds and their teaching schedule, and the schedule for Clogging, Line dancing, Contra workshops, and the Exhibitions.

The Number of Conventions attended will be on your name badge. Only you know the number of Conventions you have attended. The National Square Dance database does not pass this information on to the next Convention. Follow the bright red arrow on the left side of the Long Registration Form and fill in your number of Conventions attended next to your name on the left side of the form.

People often overlook the Dance Level area on the lower right side of the form. This information is important to schedule the halls and the callers for the dancers. If you have questions you can contact:
