

You may have heard mention of the Sets in Order magazine and wondered what it was. Caller Mike Gormley just sent me a link to a website that has copies of every one of the 444 issues that were ever printed.

This page is a tribute to Bob and Becky Osgood. The Sets In Order magazines are one of their legacys that comprise in these pages the history of modern square dancing. Bob began publishing SIO in 1948 and the last issue was issued in December 1985, 444 issues.

Excerpt from Florida Callers Association President's Message

Well this will be the final article on Square Dance Etiquette so here goes.

11. If clean up or other chores are needed at the end of the dance, volunteer to help. So many times over the years of dancing and calling (53 now) I have heard people talk about the cliques in square dancing, but I have observed that the people who are considered to be in cliques are the ones who do the "lions share" of the work. Pitch in and you also can be a part of the "clique". And above all, always clean up after yourself. (Your mother is probably not at the dance to look after you).

12. Friendliness is a part of good manners. Square dancing promotes friendliness since it offers endless opportunities in developing friendships. If you are not continually making new friends, you are not getting the most from Square dancing. A good way to ensure a friendly atmosphere is to always consider yourself as a host to ALL the other dancers at the dance.

13. Don't take Square dancing so seriously that you forget your reasons for being there: FUN & FELLOWSHIP, Smiles and laughter are contagious.
