West Coast Square & Round Dance Association Needs You!

It's that time of year again for the election of officers for the West Coast Square & Round Dance Association. For the 2013/14 year, there will be vacancies for president, vice president, and secretary. Our current vice presidents and

secretaries have been on the Board for approximately five years and are ready for a break, and our current presidents are finishing up their third non-consecutive term as president.

Please consider taking the step to become involved in keeping square and round dancing alive on the west coast of Florida. Let's take a look at some of the reasons you are giving for not becoming involved.

- I'm not here during the summer. We don't have any meetings from June through the
 end of September and we don't have any membership dances from April to August. Our
 meetings are only held in January, March, May, September, and November and the
 membership dances are scheduled a year in advance so you can plan your travel around
 these dates.
- 2. **We live too far from Lakeland** (the current location of the bi-monthly meetings). The location of these meetings is at the discretion of the president. They are currently being held in Lakeland as the entire Board is from Polk County.
- 3. **I'm too busy.** If more people were involved, there wouldn't be so much work for a very small group. It is perfectly acceptable for a solo dancer to pair up with someone or for two couples to pair up to hold an office.
- 4. **I'm a new dancer or beginning dancer.** Level of dancing or time dancing has nothing to do with holding an office with our association. The only requirement is that you have a desire to give back to square dancing and to be involved in keeping the activity going.
- 5. I don't know anything about the association or what needs to be done. Many of the current people involved in the Association have held offices previously and they would be willing to answer any questions you may have.
- 6. I don't take shorthand. The Association has a voice activated recorder and several of the recent secretaries have used their laptops during the meeting to record minutes. There are also people available to proofread for you.

Please give this some serious thought to this and if you have any questions, please feel free to talk to any of the current officers or any previous officers. You can make some lifetime friends by becoming involved in the association.

With the start of the new year, there will be some other positions that will probably need to be filled too i.e. county reps. Please check the inside cover of the West Coast Dancer to see what committees/positions we have. Why not consider attending a Folding/Business Meeting to see what is involved and what a great bunch of people you would be working with?

2014 Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention

Did you know that the 2014 Florida State Convention will be the 60th anniversary of Florida conventions? This is will be a special event and you will want to be a part of the activities. Did you also know that two representatives from the West Coast Association area are co-chairs of this convention? Sixty years of having conventions; that is something to celebrate! You will want to make plans to attend this special event.

The co-chairs are the mother and daughter team of Penny and Jenny Green from the Lakeland area. Work has already begun on this convention and there is a lot more to do.

At the 2013 convention there will be a kick-off for the 2014 convention. This is an invitation to attend our convention. Keith Stevens, our caller chairman, has been working on planning our kick-off entertainment which will be held on Sunday night of the 2013 convention. We will need 32 square dance volunteers and approximately eight round dance couples to participate. Since the participants will be from all around the state, there will only be one rehearsal which will be held Sunday morning at 7:00 a.m. Why so early? There are so many meetings, workshops, dancing, and meetings during a convention weekend that 7:00 a.m. is the only time available! It will be a very simple routine and will be easy to learn. Everyone who participates in the kick-off is asked to wear purple and white (the guys can wear white or black slacks). Please feel free to wear casual attire for the rehearsal. - When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/ her.
- 2. Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
