

Does the Callers and Cuers Insurance Insure the Dancers?

NO! Many times we have been told by callers that if they have insurance the dancers at their dances are covered by their insurance. I have just found verification that this is not true. Following is an excerpt from "USDA Insurance Coordinators Notes" which was in the first quarter issue of USDA Notes:

"Many times I hear a club member say that a caller run club does not need USDA insurance as "their caller" said the dancers in his club are covered by his insurance through Caller Lab. The following appeared in the July-August 2014 Callerlab's Newsletter: ["As information, CALLERLAB's general liability insurance **covers our Members only**. Clubs and officers are not covered by CALLERLAB's policy. United States Dancers of America (USDA) can provide general liability insurance to dancers and club leaders. Clubs are encouraged to contact USDA for insurance liability coverage.]" ROUNDALAB also provides a \$1,000,000 comprehensive bodily injury and property damage liability insurance policy for all teaching and cueing activities **for its members.** (Copied from <u>http://www.roundalab.org/Who_What.html</u>)


