It is with sadness that we announce the passing of our father, Midford "Mid" Joseph Kitchen (1926-2019). Mid passed away peacefully on Saturday October 19, 2019 in Parry Sound, Ontario. Predeceased by his parents (Reg Kitchen and Wenonah Moore), and his wife (Joy Stinson), he is survived by his daughter Maureen (Doug) and son Reg (Donna).

Dad was an incredible person - organized, intelligent, focused, great story-teller, a hard-working man, and a skilled builder with a vast knowledge pool; we will greatly miss him! His loves were Mom, being out on the water (Georgian Bay), the military, square dancing, horseshoe pitching, and his Florida winter home; he had many friends and acquaintances all over North America. He was a man before his time and would have happily been born 300 years ago as an early seafarer and explorer. Later in life, when his genealogy DNA results came back, he was thrilled to find out he had some "Viking" bits in him.

After his discharge from the army, Dad graduated in Civil Engineering from University of Toronto (class of 4T8), finishing in 3 years with no breaks. He married Mom and the family lived in many locations as he was promoted and transferred.

Dad and Mom were square dancing Challenge dancers and loved attending conventions all over Canada and the USA. Dad was also a skilled horseshoe pitcher and travelled across Canada and the USA to compete in various tournaments.

When Dad retired, Dad and Mom bought a motor home and spent the better part of a year exploring and meandering around Canada and the USA. During these travels, they found Riverwoods Plantation in Florida and decided to make it their winter base. After that, summers were spent on Idletime Island near Parry Sound with winters in their Florida home enjoying the sun and all the good friends they made there.

Cremation has taken place. Respecting Dad's wishes, only a private family service will be held at Hillcrest Cemetery.

If desired, donations to a military veterans' association would be gratefully appreciated.

Mid was a dancer in the Fort Myers area in southwest Florida.



Word was recently received regarding the condition of **Leila Lindsey**. Leila was at the last state convention and was walking around unassisted and did some dancing.

On October 4th, she awoke paralyzed. Her husband, Ellis had difficulty waking her up and when she awoke, she was unable to speak. She eventually overcame that and was released from the hospital to hospice home care.

She is <u>not</u> with hospice because she's going to die; she just needs assistance in many areas for her day-to-day care. She has a nurse that comes twice a week, a bather twice a week, a physical therapist twice a week, and an occupational therapist twice a week.

On October 23rd, she returned to the hospital for hypothermia. Humana denied the bill because the hospital had been filing phony claims. They have run every test possible to determine her diagnosis but everything comes back that she is ok and there's nothing wrong with her. She has not been given any reason why she can't walk, why she stumbles and staggers, and why she is in a wheelchair. She is unable to ride her horse, clean her house, walk, or dance. Of course, she is very depressed.

Her husband, **Ellis**, has aggravated an old back injury, for which he receives disability, because he has had to pick her up.

Leila fell out of her wheelchair one night upon arriving home late one night after riding for 62 miles from a dance at Citrus Squares in Dunnellon. She was unable to get herself up and into her chair and Ellis had to lift her without any help from Leila.

Are you a new dancer looking for some reinforcement of what you have learned in class? Are you a returning dancer trying to remember what you learned 30 years ago? Or maybe you have been dancing for a while and you just want to review so you can be a better dancer? Let me introduce you to the Traveling Hoedowners!

Back in the early 2000's, Caller Paul Place moved to Orlando and began calling at Whirl & Twirl in Orlando. He quickly became very popular in Orlando and he started branching out to the west coast of Florida. Paul decided to get a square of dancers together to make some instructional DVDs. The original group was comprised of Ray and Joyce Helmuth, Ian and Sandy Ogilvie, Bruce and Debbie Popson, and Michael and Alice Craft.

They recorded several DVDs using professional videographers, filming two of their DVDs at the empty Whirl & Twirl hall on Ventura Circle. They formed a company, built a website, and began selling DVDs with a lot of success.

Unfortunately, we lost Paul to cancer in 2008. This was a big loss to the square dance community. If any of you dance at Shufflin' Squares at Lake Ashton, stop by the Veteran's Memorial near the main clubhouse to see the memorial brick that was laid in memory of Major Paul Place (U.S. Army Major, Retired). Paul called at Shufflin' Squares several times and the Lake Ashton Veteran's Committee approved this memorial brick.

The square continued dancing, producing and advertising the sale of their DVDs and also did several demos in the Orlando area. The makeup of the square has changed; two couples have dropped out and of course, replacement callers have been used.

In 2011, they produced their "Instant Hoedown" DVD with Callers Scotty Sharrer and Roland Morin and two substitute dance couples. It is designed to introduce non-dancers to our wonderful sport, and teaches about half the Basic and Mainstream calls with dancing after each lesson to keep learning fun. Their DVDs are of real couples dancing, not stick figures or X's drawn on a piece of paper. They demonstrate the correct way of doing all the Mainstream and Plus calls on their two Reference DVDs, and their non0instructional Square Dance Party 2-DVD 2-CD set can be played for dances. These DVDs are all sold internationally.

"Selling" Square Dancing?

Experienced square dancers try to "sell" square dancing or the idea of square dancing to their friends and it rarely works. This is because people aren't looking to buy square dancing. It doesn't fit their idea of what they need.

In 1954, the president of the American Society of Training Directors, Cloyd Steinmetz, told grocers to quit selling their product and, instead, sell the benefits of those products. "They sell a quarter of a million dollars' worth of drill bits a week," said Steinmetz. "Nobody wants a drill bit, they want a hole," he said. People that buy drills and drill bits don't really care about the hardware. They need the holes the drills make.

So, stop trying to sell square dancing. Yes, you should speak to its benefits and how much you enjoy it. Instead, try selling what square dancing provides. Square dancing:

- Strengthens relationships: Couples that dance together, stay together.
- Helps create new friendships: Square dancers have active social lives in a smoke-free, alcohol-free, and well-lit environment.
- Promotes life-long learning: Even those that never leave the Basic or Mainstream programs will always experience something new. It could be music, choreography, or something interpersonal.
- Is low-impact aerobic activity. What doctor has ever said, "I think you're too active. You should sit more."

When you buy...

- ...an automobile you buy transportation.
- ...a mattress you are buying comfortable sleep.
- ...a razor, you're buying smooth skin.
- ...new clothes, you buy an improved/updated appearance.
- ...square dancing, you buy improved relationships to with your significant other and your neighbors.

CHANGING TIMES: THE FUTURE OF YELLOW ROCK

In recent years we have seen a sharp rise in sexual harassment issues in the news, including confidential agreements, high profile trials, and resignations of people in prominent positions. What is and is not sexual harassment is a subject of widespread debate.

Yellow Rock, including variations with other names, has been part of the square dance activity for over 50 years. This name for hugging was invented by a caller calling at Yellow Rock Barn outside of Kansas City, MO. For decades people considered Yellow Rock harmless fun and a way to increase friendliness in square dancing. But in these changing times of sexual harassment focus, it may be time to take another look at Yellow Rock.

The Board of Governors (25 callers) of CALLERLAB did so at a recent annual convention, where considerable time was devoted to a discussion of the issue. Male members, who comprise a majority of the Board, were genuinely concerned about whether they could be accused of sexual harassment if they called Yellow Rock. In addition, they worried whether they could be accused if they themselves gave someone a Yellow Rock.

Female members of the Board described their experiences of appropriate and inappropriate Yellow Rocks that they had received over the years. It quickly became clear that there is a fine line between appropriate and inappropriate hugging, and that this line is different for each person - both the giver and the receiver of the Yellow Rock.

Male callers were concerned that they might be reported to CALLERLAB for an ethics violation if they call Yellow Rock, even though there is currently nothing specific on this topic in the CALLERLAB Code of Ethics. They were also concerned they might be reported if they gave a Yellow Rock to someone -- reported either by the person who received the Yellow Rock or by someone viewing the action from across the room.

More on Yellow Rock. It was suggested that callers take a poll of their home clubs, to see if people liked Yellow Rock. But it was quickly noted that unless this was a secret ballot, no one would vote against it because such a stand could cause embarrassment and be perceived as unfriendly. Also, if just one person voted against Yellow Rock, that person might possibly claim sexual harassment in the future, based on that person's definition of what is appropriate.

One caller said he only calls Yellow Rock with the original partner. This was fine decades ago, when most couples were married. But he recognized that in this day of so many singles dancing with various people during a dance, this is probably no longer appropriate.

The story was told of a well-known caller who started a large beginners class. This caller recognized that the personal space of new dancers was much larger than those who have

danced a long time, so he intentionally never showed Yellow Rock until later in class. This caller had to miss the third night of class, and the replacement caller showed Yellow Rock. The next week half the class had quit, because their personal space had been invaded in a manner unacceptable to them.

Bottom line. The Board took no vote on this issue, and callers are free to call Yellow Rock as they wish. But many callers on the Board said they had already stopped calling Yellow Rock, and others said they planned to do so. They all agreed it was just a no-win situation for them. So, while Yellow Rock will not be going away, it is likely to be used far less in the future. When you notice that the use of Yellow Rock is in decline, remember the observations made here and you will know the reason.

A note to callers. At the meeting, male callers asked the female callers what to do if a woman walks up to you with arms outstretched, obviously wanting a Yellow Rock. This can happen at any time during a dance, and especially in a "thank you line" at the end of a dance. If the male caller steps forward too far (in the mind of the woman), it could be considered an aggressive move. But if he does not move at all, this could be considered unfriendly. What to do?

Answer from the female callers: The male caller should turn his body sideways 90 degrees - this will cause the woman to turn her body to face the same direction as the man. Then the man puts his arm around the woman's back and gives a half hug. The female callers said this was a perfect solution.

Likewise, if a male approaches a female caller with arms outstretched, the female caller can turn sideways 90 degrees and give a half hug. This keeps her in control of the situation.

Square "Angel" Appreciation

I am truly blessed and thankful for the amazing support that my "angels" give me each week when I teach my class. They put such excitement in the room and so many of them bring food and snacks for everyone to enjoy too. As I watch my club members interact with our new dancers it as if they're each entertaining guests in their own home.

The back table of food services as a large area for our new dancers and club members to socialize and get to know each other. I believe that it's one of the main reasons our new dancers stay with the class, graduate, and join the club. If your members get to know your new

dancers and those relationships build, you new dancers will keep coming back and will become a great part of your club.

Our club puts out a handbook each year lists the club dances and then has a picture of each couple or individual member, their address, phone, email, and the year they joined the club. The bylaws are also included in the back of the book, but I'm not sure that everyone reads those thoroughly. At the end of the handbook, there are several pages for personal notes. I love this book, because with over 230 members, it gives me the opportunity to know everyone's name and how long they've been involved with the club.

Our new dancer program is open for 3 to 4 weeks before we close the class and move forward with my teaching. Once that happens, our club photographer takes photos of all our new dancers and publishes a page with names and photos to distribute to everyone. I love this too because I get to know the names of all our new dancers and so does every class "angel". These special things that help us all get to know each other, along with many of the ideas that come from the CALLERLAB Marketing Manual, have helped put almost 50 new dancers into our program this year so far. We still have one more open week, so I'm hopeful we'll have more new dancers join us. Way to go buckles & Bows!

Below are just some of the things your "angels" can do to really help your caller/teacher and your new dancer program go smoothly. Share these with your "angels" and make each night a great event that keeps those new dancers coming back and your club members coming out to help.

- 1. Arrive at the class dance at least ten minutes early.
- 2. Help the caller/instructor carry his/her equipment before and after the dance.
- 3. Help set up chairs, tables, and refreshments as needed.
- 4. Greet the new dancers when they come in and make them feel welcome.
- 5. Fill in squares quickly. If possible, stronger dancers should ask the new dancers who might need more help to dance.
- 6. Attempt to have a least equal numbers of "angels" and new dancers in each square.
- 7. Visit with the new dancers during breaks. One of the main reasons for having square "angels" is to get to know our new dancers, enjoy new friendships, and be a good support group.
- 8. Let the caller/instructor do the teaching during the tip. If you notice that a new dancers needs reinforcement on a given call or concept, please raise your hand and ask the instructor to go over the definition and applicable rules. If one person does not fully understand something, there may be others who also need the reinforcement.
- 9. Let the new dancer make the first movement on each call. Don't be afraid to let the new dancer made a mistake. If a mistake is repeated, then request reinforcement from the instructor. When obvious help is needed to keep the square from continuing to break down, be as gentle as possible with any needed assistance. Sometimes it may be possible to point to where a new dancer is supposed to go.

- 10. Make sure to re-join hands with the adjacent dancers after completing a call. Do a normal Do Sa Do and don't kick or extra twirls, even with other "angels".
- 11. When a square breaks down, make lines of fur and follow the CALLERLAB Lost Squares Procedure. Don't encourage the immediate return to original partners.
- 12. If the instructor makes a mistake, do as he/she instructs. Do not try to correct the call or instruction. In general, dance as if you were a class member yourself except for always trying to be in the right place at the right time.
- 13. Say goodbye and be encouraging to the new dancers at the end of the evening.
- 14. Help clean up when the evening is over.
- 15. Have Fun!





- When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her
- The remaining couples join hands and take a step backward.

 This will allow the injured person and

the attendant air and room

- Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle
- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately respond and place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid if required.
