We just received word that **Ken Brasfield** passed away on March 21<sup>st</sup>. All of his children were there and he passed quietly.

Ken and hisa wife Sand were very active in the square dance community in the West Coast Association area of Florida.

They were part of a group of square dancers headed up by Caller Susanelaine Packer and her mother, Bettylee Talmadge, and participated in the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration at Disney World twice (1987 and 1988), danced in the Citrus Bowl halftime with Larry Gatlin and the Gatlin Brothers, and Mickey's Very Merry Christmas.

Ken and Sandy were the presidents of the Left Allemanders in 1988-1989, West Coast Vice Presidents in 1993-1994 and 2006-2007, Presidents in 1994-1995 and 2007-2008, Copresidents in 2008-2009, Florida Federation President in 2001-2002 which was a five year commitment, and West Coast Association Fall Fun Fest Chairpersons in 1994 and 1996. They were delegates to the Florida Federation for many years.

They received the Circle of Service Award in 1996 and the West Coast Association President's Choice Award in 2001.

They were members of the Left Allemanders in St. Pete, and Chapter 139 Limonaders.
